The Senior Champion class will consist of winners in classes 9, 10 and 11. The Junior Champion class will consist of winners in classes, 1, 2 and 3.

The Grand Champion class will consist of best of breed in each division.

Market/Meat Goats

- Entries are limited to members of the Monroe County 4-H Livestock Club.
- Maximum of 3 meat goats (1 per division).
- All market goats must have a full est of kid teeth. Any animal displaying yearling teeth will be disqualified.
- Project animals must be wethers or does for the market goat project.
- Entries mush have their horns removed.
- Goats must be born after November 1 of the year prior to the project year and in member's possession by May 1 of the project year.
- Minimum weight for market goats will be 55lbs. and may not exceed 120 lbs.
- Market goats cannot be show in both market and breading classes.
- All animal entries are subject to the West End Fair Association health guidelines and requirements.
- For complete project rules and requirements, members may contact their club leader or the extension office.
- All goats must be ear tagged with an official USDA scrapies program ear tag. Members will be allowed to show one animal per class.
- 14. Weight divisions will be determined after final weigh-in.
