  - \* Uniformity in shape, size and color.

- \* Be sure to pick out a perfect specimen, then select the others as similar to it as possible.
- \* Never mix specimens of different maturity.
- \* Protect from dirt, disease, infection, and mechanical damage.
- \* Select specimens that are perfect and show no blemishes of any kind.
- \* Condition and maturity. Be sure exhibits are of high quality.
- \* Potatoes should not be washed. Remove all soil using a soft cloth or brush.
- \* Tomatoes should have stems removed. Carrots, beets, etc. should have tops removed from vegetable leaving about two inches of stem.

\*Read premium material carefully, following all rules and regulations. If any entry requires a specific number of specimens, be sure to exhibit the stated amount. Exhibits will be disqualified if the correct number is not entered.
