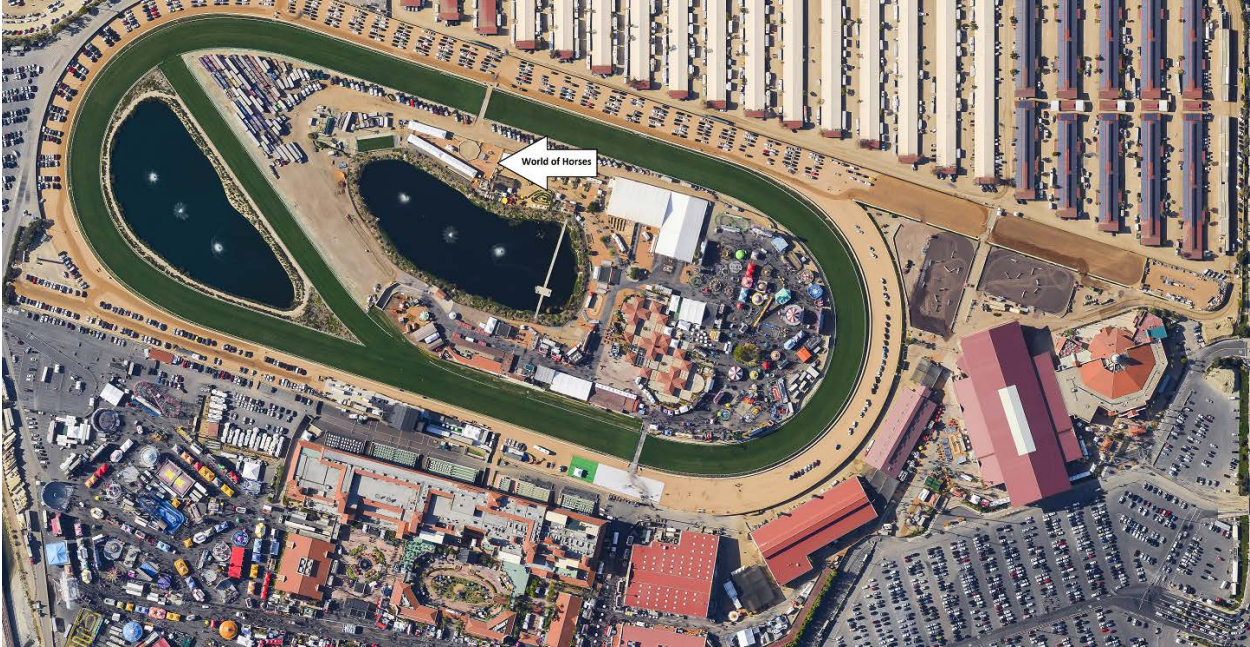

GYPSY TIME TRAVELERS



FABULOUS STORYTELLING WITH A HOT IRON TWIST

Some people are just good at spinning a tale. If you have a moment, be sure to seek out the Gypsy Time Travelers in Family Funville, and sit a spell to listen to Bard Christy Horne share her legends and lore while Master Blacksmith Michel Olson rhythmically hammers away in the background creating numerous metal objects during the Fair. For about 30 minutes, four times a day, Christy pulls from her magic bag of stories and shares with the audience, while Michel works his blacksmith magic. He gives away his items to the audience as a memento of the folklore, handing out about 4,000 items through free drawings over the run of the Fair. Look for a magical and elaborate covered wagon on the way to the World of Horses, sort of an original road rig they call "Florence." Named after Christy's grandmother, Florence provides them with their stage, blacksmith shop and "recreational castle" for sleeping and eating while they wind their way across the country telling their stories. They spend seven to nine months each year travelling and living the gypsy life.

One of the centerpieces is a 380-pound anvil made in England about 1840, brought to the United States by ship during the California Gold Rush.



"This is one of the anvils that helped build the West. We are extra proud to keep her ringing," says Michel, as he hammers metal into unusual shapes on the anvil. These gypsies have some other interesting items like a real meteorite and a huge old lock and key set, fun for the kids. If you miss them at this Fair, they are said to be found at a few other fairs and rodeos and even have been spotted at Burning Man and the Reagan Library in Los Angeles.
