a) What was the goal? Define the challenge/ problem/target audience and explain what you were trying to accomplish.

The goal for our new children's program was to encourage and bring in our local children from the San Mateo County to attend our Fair to be exposed to new learning hands on experiences. We want to inspire the new generation and make them lifelong fairgoers. We want all of our youth to have the opportunity to experience our Great American tradition and be inspired to learn more with our hands-on activities. We have several programs for our youth, including the Read2Ride Program, the STEM Passport Program, Super Science, Tapigami, Rainforest Adventure and the Bookmobile.

b) How did you achieve the goal? What steps were taken to solve the problem or accomplish the goal? Who was involved in the project? Include any working relationships with other agencies/groups.

To achieve this goal, we started our School Ticket Program titled "Ticket to Fair School", where we worked to provide every elementary school student (K-5th grade) a free ticket to the Fair. For this outreach program we started working directly with our school systems in San Mateo County. We first establisehd a relationship with the San Mateo County Office of Education, specifically with the County Superintendent and County Marketing Director. The Office of Education provided us with all the contact information for the public elementary schools, and private schools in the county. Due to our relationship with the Office of Education we were able to work together on the creation of the forms and the distribution information to the schools. The Fair Operations Manager was able to presented to all the county superintendents about the program. We also advertised on our website and on social media about the program to encourage schools to submit the form by May 1 and if they did not send in the form then they did not get tickets. Forms were sent out in February to superintendents and principals, and we did 2 follow emails. Once we received the forms staff would process the request and count out the tickets. We did a massive delivery day during the 3rd week of May before school went out.

c) What were the results? Include tangible and quantifiable benefits such as financial, public or media awareness and attendance. Use percentages when applicable. There were a total of 47 schools that participated in the program, this included public schools, private schools, catholic schools and home schools. We had 40% overall participation from county public schools and we were able to track district participation within the county. With all the schools combined we handed out 22,000 free tickets to students, which was potentially 22,000 new faces for the Fair. We received popular response from the public about the program, especially for families that were not able to afford to come to the Fair. Also, we established ourselves as a worthwhile partner for the San Mateo County Office of Education, and they are more amenable to work with us in the future. We were able to increase overall attendance and our youth attendance was noticeable up from 2016. We hope in 2018 to create a specific code for the school tickets so that we can determine how many were redeemed at the 2018 Fair.




