a) What was the goal? Define the challenge/ problem/target audience and explain what you were trying to accomplish.

Our goal was to increase our local sponsor programming. We have a robust corporate sponsorship program but we wanted to increase our local stakeholders commitment. We also need to build and maintain relationships with our local community stakeholders to protect our continued interest in the Fair and Event Center.

b) How did you achieve the goal? What steps were taken to solve the problem or accomplish the goal? Who was involved in the project? Include any working relationships with other agencies/groups.

We work with Event Partnership, LLC for our corporate sponsorship, but we wanted to engage with a local group for our local sponsors. We established a connection with PR Magic, lead by Frances Larose, who is a PR and Marketing partner in the area. With PR Magic we built the "Donor Program", a program that focused on gathering local sponsors and donors to the Fair. We created 6 different donor levels or packages that groups could chose from, with 2 of the levels created just for our Fair Parade. Each level had a dollar range and would "sponsor" different aspects of the Fair (like Family 4 Packs, School Tours, etc), and the perks towards the donor would increase with the more money contributed. The perks included inclusion on our website, Fair Program, tickets to the Fair and tickets to our VIP Party. PR Magic then went out to the community to solicit donors. They did so through email blasts, grassroots marketing, and working with the different Cities' Chambers of Commerce in the County. Once PR Magic got a committment, the Fair department would follow up to process all the perks. During the Fair we had donor information posted at our 2 Guest Services locations, and we had donors that participated in our parade.

c) What were the results? Include tangible and quantifiable benefits such as financial, public or media awareness and attendance. Use percentages when applicable.

In our first year we had 8 donors total and \$5,200 money was collected. With the money we were able to produce our Passport to Fair Fun activity (which was a STEM scavanager hunt on the fairgrounds) at no cost to the Fairgrounds. We were excited about the first year numbers and we were able to establish a foundation for the next year. We also had several of the donors come out to enjoy the Fair and they were happy with the results.

San Mateo County Fair History:

The San Mateo County Fair is held for 9 days, starting on Saturday June 10th and running through Sunday, June 18, 2017. Originally called the 'Little Flower Show' in 1926 and held in various schools around San Mateo County, the Fair was revitalized in 1935 and brought to its current location by the Bay Meadows Racetrack where it currently resides at the San Mateo Event Center.

The Fair has long been a staple of our community, bringing families from all over San Mateo County together through contests, concerts, entertainment, attractions, and interactive exhibits. To make the Fair a success, we work with local businesses, organizations and individuals to create partnerships within our community that generate awareness about the greater San Mateo County's diversity and rich heritage.

VIP Party (The Fair Party):

The Fair Party will take place on Monday, June 12th from 5:00pm-6:30pm in Cypress Hall on the fairgrounds during the Fair. The Fair Party is where we invite our VIPs to celebrate the Fair. These VIPs include County officials, City officials, the Fair Board of Directors, our corporate sponsors, and our local donors.

"Spring into Summer" Fair Parade:

This is the first year that the San Mateo County Fair will kick off its festivities with a local parade! Presented by the City of San Mateo and the San Mateo County Fair, the "Spring into Summer" Parade will take place on June 10th with the opening celebration starting in the Franklin Templeton parking lot. The fanfare will continue down Franklin Parkway, turn onto Delaware St. and then end at the San Mateo Event Center to mark the grand opening of the Fair.

Parade Floats and Large Balloons:

If you would like to donate at the Caramel Apple (Sapphire) level, we would have professional balloon handlers march the balloons in the Fair Parade. Any of your staff may accompany the handlers and march with them. The balloons would be similar to Macy's Day Parade balloons.

If you donate at the Funnel Cake (Platinum) level, we will have professional float makers work with your company on the design of your parade float. The float will be built and completely taken care of by these professionals. Your company can put staff or whomever on the float, or just walk alongside it during the

Parade.

Displaying your Company Information:

All of our donors are have the option to display their brochures, pamphlets, and fliers at the two Guest Services locations which also serve as Information Booths. These are at the two entrances to the fair, so these areas get a lot of traffic from our guests!

VIP Pre-Parade Reception:

We are waiting on more details about this Pre-Parade Reception, and we will let you know details as soon as we are able! This is something that the Fair board is working on with the City of San Mateo.

Golden Circle Concerts:

Top-notch performers play at the Fair's Golden Circle Concert. In the past, the Fair has been host to performers such as Johnny Cash, the Village People, Charlie Daniels Band, Boyz II Men, and more! This year, we have confirmed the following lineup of performers: The concerts take place at 7:30 pm with Gold Circle opening at 6:15 pm. The concerts are about 1.5 hours, and they take place in our Fiesta Hall, giving an indoor concert experience.

Passport to Fair Fun:

The Fair is always trying to implement innovative ways to bring fun and creativity to children's educational programs. For the first time we have created an activity called "Passport to Fair Fun." Children will receive Passport booklets at the Guest Services booths at each entrance (they will also be able to download them online). Then, the kids will be encouraged to find the 10 locations around the Fair that are listed in the Passport booklet. At each location, they get their Passport stamped after learning a STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) Fair Fact. When the child acquires all the locations and their stamps, they are then instructed to turn their booklets in at the Guest Services booths. Once they have turned in their Passport booklet, they will be entered into a drawing for prizes.

Special Press Releases:

For donors contributing \$3,500 and up, the San Mateo Event Center will disseminate special press releases to the media featuring your business and highlighting your company's generosity toward the Fair and the San Mateo Community.




