YQCA BACKGROUND

Youth for the Quality Care of Animals is the food safety, animal well-being and life skills awareness, education, and certification program for youth producers ages 8 to 21.

Initial meeting – Summer 2013 Included National Pork Board, states with approved youth quality assurance programs, other species groups and industry representatives Organized planning meetings – September and December 2014 Survey/program research conducted Prototype developed Began planning for the organization of YQCA and its program – January, May and June 2015 Establishment of sub-committees - Platform, Program and Policy, Promotion and Fundraising, Initial fundraising efforts Curriculum, Research and Evaluation Began YQCA development – mid-2017 Contract with RegistrationMax to deliver Contract with Vivayic to develop the Continued sub-committee work Continued fundraising efforts Begin promoting YQCA curriculum components of YQCA YQCA online Officially established Youth for the Quality Care of Animals – September 2016

Launched YQCA- 2017

Additional modules will be launch in March of 2018 and March of 2019, completing the YQCA curriculum

The second set of instructor-led training materials will be launch in August of 2018 and August of 2019

Instructor-Led Training Web-Based Training

YQCA Implementation Options

Online Certification

\$12.00/user online annually User fees paid by user

YQCA program is available on YQCA website

Complete customer support provided to user

User consent to data use by YQCA

No state involvement in the program

No state-level reports provided

User may log on using 4-H Online credentials or create YQCA credentials

Instructor-Led Training Certification

\$3.00/user annually User fees paid by user

Organizations (e.g., State 4-H/youth extension offices, State Ag Ed/FFA offices, national or state species groups, national or state level junior livestock/animal associations) must sign an agreement with YQCA to:

- Acknowledge that all YQCA materials are copyrighted and the property of YQCA
- Agree that all instructors may only utilize the YQCA materials for registered training events

Organizations also acknowledge and agree to the following:

- Designate one person to identify the certified instructors for their organization
- Designate qualified instructors who are extension professionals, agriculture education instructors, or veterinarians to the YQCA Program Manager
- Instructors must complete an annual training provided by YQCA and must agree to the terms and conditions of use
- YQCA certification trainings shall
 - Be made available only to youth in Junior, Intermediate and Senior levels
 - Be provided in a workshop with a minimum of 1, 60-minute in-person, instructor-led session
- Instructors must select one of the YQCA base trainings. They may add additional materials as they see fit, but may not modify or omit the base training
- Trainers may charge local fees for materials and costs; those fees are collected locally

As part of this agreement, YQCA will provide:

- An accurate, up-to-date, peer-reviewed youth quality assurance curriculum
- YQCA user with customer and technical support
- Program implementation support from YQCA program managers
- Annual state aggregate reporting data to assist in federal reporting purposes
- National research findings, if conducted

YQCA Fees

\$12.00 fee for online program

- \$0.36 = credit card fees (typically)
- \$5.00 = technical/user support, email and phone support, based in U.S.
- \$5.00 = online system hosting, maintenance, ongoing development, security and privacy assurance
- \$1.64 = stays with YQCA to invest in ongoing curriculum development and revision, program management, and promotion

\$3 fee for in-person

- \$0.09 = credit card fees (typically)
- \$1.50 = technical/user support, email and phone support, based in U.S.
- \$1.41 = online system hosting, maintenance, ongoing development, security and privacy assurance

Cancellations are allowed prior to youth beginning their web-based course and up to 24 hours prior to an instructor-led training. Registered youth will receive an email 48 hours prior to their scheduled instructor-led training to remind them of the event.
