Buyers will be invoiced by April 22, 2024 and we ask that payment be made by May 20, 2024 in order that exhibitors may be paid in a timely manner. WCYF will assess 1.5 % interest per month to all outstanding invoice balances that are not paid within 60 days of the date of the invoice.

***To purchase PRE-SALE, buyer must pay the maximum price listed for that project.

***The Freezer Sale will start immediately following the last lot of the Sale of Excellence. All projects not sold during the PRE-SALE will be sold to the highest bidder, but bids may not exceed the maximum price listed. The first person with the highest bid as indicated by the spotters will be the successful buyer.

***Roasters, rabbits and broilers will be processed by the exhibitors and delivered to the buyer no later than April 8, 2024. If a buyer fails to receive a project by that date, please call the Fair office at 979-677-3350. Exhibitors will be responsible for immediate contact with the buyer for instructions on delivery and/or processing. Pen of three heifers and commercial heifers should be delivered according to the buyer's wishes since these items are not normally processed. All exhibitors should be certain to obtain the name of the buyer of their project. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to contact the buyer for further instructions! Wharton County Youth Fair will issue no disposition instructions, only the buyer's telephone numbers.

***Recent changes have been made in the IRS laws regarding donations to charitable organizations. The Wharton County Youth Fair has been advised that we may be acting only as an agent during the sale and therefore may not be able to acknowledge the purchase of an animal as a donation. It is our understanding that businesses considering the purchase as a business promotion expense or advertising expense will not be affected by the changes.

WCYF will gladly accept donations to the General Scholarship Fund. If you purchase an animal for which we have provided a floor market and would like to donate it to the General Scholarship Fund, we will floor the animal and the General Scholarship Fund will receive the market value.

WCYF now accepts Discover, MasterCard, and Visa credit card payments with a 3% convenience fee.
