We will soon be wrapping up 2023 and then the countdown to Fair time gets real! We have tagged in pen of three heifers, commercial heifers, steers, lambs and goats. There were 108 exhibitors who tagged in 128 commercial heifers; 43 exhibitors who tagged in 54 steers and 30 exhibitors who tagged in 139 heifers for pen of three. The Dairy Merit Heifer program has 3 exhibitors for 2024, and there are 21 roaster and 13 broiler exhibitors.

Again, this year leg hairs will be pulled on all market animals (commercial heifers, steers, lambs, goats and swine). See Rule #2 of general rules The hair follicles will be placed in an envelope and sealed. The exhibitor, parent, AST or 4H leader and the technician pulling the hair will all sign off on the envelope. The envelopes will be stored with a third-party entity.
