There are 1,065 Creative Arts exhibitors who will enter 4,196 entries.

PARENT WORK RULE

March 1 is the deadline to sign up to work a shift to fulfill the Parent Work Rule. If you have not signed up to work, there are still a few spots available. Remember, a parent or guardian of any student exhibiting a project at the WCYF (excluding Bucket Calf) is required to work a minimum of three (3) hours per exhibitor.
