There were 35 exhibitors who tagged in heifers for the Pen of Three, 41 Steers exhibitors and 99 Commercial Heifer exhibitors. The Dairy Merit Heifer program has three exhibitors for 2020.

Important Upcoming Dates

Wednesday, November 6 – Roaster Order dead line

\$2.40/bird plus \$30 entry fee. Minimum of 25 roasters, no more than 50 (only available in increments of 25). Birds must be ordered through WCYF.

Tuesday, November 12 – Lamb & Goat Tag in

6:30 - 7:30 p.m. - Fairgrounds

Refer to Livestock & Poultry Rulebook for a complete list of rules.

Entry forms for all species are available on the web site. Don't forget entry forms must be signed by the exhibitor, parent/guardian and FFA/4-H leader. We must have a NEW release of liability on file for each exhibitor every year. First-

time exhibitors must also turn in a completed W-9 form with the exhibitor's social security number, not a parents' number.


