We were busy in October tagging in pen of three heifers, commercial heifer and steers. This month we will tag in lambs and goats, as well as order roasters. There were 31 exhibitors who tagged in heifers for the Pen of Three, 32 steer exhibitors and 85 commercial heifer exhibitors. The Dairy Merit Heifer program has 11 exhibitors for 2021.

Check the calendar for details on lamb and goat tag-in and roaster ordering deadlines. Don't forget about the online registration for Livestock/Poultry and Creative Arts. It's easy, fast and leaves less room for entry errors. Pay online, print off your receipt, obtain the signatures and bring to tag in.

Important Upcoming Dates

Wednesday, November 4 – Roaster Ordering deadline

\$2.40/bird plus \$30 entry fee. Minimum of 25 roasters, no more than 50 (only available in increments of 25). Birds must be ordered through WCYF.

Tuesday, November 10 – Lamb & Goat Tag in
5:30 - 6:30 p.m. - Fairgrounds

Refer to the [Livestock & Poultry Rulebook](#) for a complete list of rules.

Entry forms for all species are available on the web site. **Don't forget entry forms must be signed by the exhibitor, parent/guardian and FFA/4-H leader.** We must have a NEW release of liability on file for each exhibitor every year. First-time exhibitors must also turn in a completed W-9 form with the exhibitor's social security number, not a parents' number.

Reminder: A parent or guardian of any student exhibiting a project at the WCYF (excluding Bucket Calf) is required to work a minimum of three (3) hours per exhibitor.
