

# **CHUTE & BARREL JUNIOR RODEO CLUB**

## **WCYF RODEO**

The Chute & Barrel Junior Rodeo Club would like to invite the youth of Wharton County and any CBJRC members to attend our WCYF Rodeo SUNDAY March 26<sup>th</sup>, 2023. The rodeo will begin at 1:00 p.m. with lead line first.

### **PRIZES**

- All Around Buckles to first place boy & girl in each age group EXCEPT LEADLINE.
- Each Contestant will receive a participation prize.

### **RULES**

1. **PARENTS:** We are going to need your help this year to make this event a success. **A parent, a senior, or a junior contestant will need to work 1 event for each contestant.** If you cannot work, another adult, senior or junior age contestant may work in your place.

2. No hazing of the livestock will be allowed.

3. We will abide by all TYRA rules with the following exceptions:

**Ribbons:** Time will end when ribbon is pulled from calf's tail. If ribbon falls off before roper reaches calf, roper will get another calf. Roper must have someone to mug calf.

**Jr. Tiedown:** A whistle will be blown at 30 seconds. CRC will designate an adult to throw the calf. A 3 second penalty will be added to the roper's time if assisted. Roper can refuse help by notifying the designated adult before entering the box. If calf is not daylighted 3 seconds will be added to time.

**Goat Ribbon Pulling:** Contestant can be helped off horse without penalty

**DRESS CODE: Hats are optional. NO CAPS!** (For example, you will need to wear a long-sleeved, button-up collared shirt with cuffs, jeans, belt, hat, and riding boots).

4. Back gate will be **OPEN** for all roping events.

5. Contestant will be called three (3) times and then we will move on to the next contestant. Be ready when your name is called!

6. All stock will be chute run.

7. Back gate will remain open in all speed events. A parent must tell gate worker whether or not to close the gate before entering arena.

8. Decisions of the arena directors and judges will be **FINAL. NO PROTESTS!**

9. Neck ropes must be used on tiedown and ribbon roping.

10. Current Coggins papers required at gate.

11. **Team roping: A roper may enter once as a header and once as a heeler.** If you would like to rope with a certain roper, please make arrangements with that person and designate the roper you want to be teamed with on your entry form. If you do not have a partner, you will be matched with a roper who does not have a partner, or, a courtesy roper will be drawn for you. The points from the highest placing will be the only set of points that will count for all-around.

12. If you have a project you are showing on the day of our rodeo, we will try to work with you to get your events done.

**You must designate on your entry blank if you are showing.**

## ORDER OF EVENTS

Figure 8's, goat ribbon pulling, goat tying, breakaway roping, cloverleaf, ribbon roping, tie down roping, poles, team roping.

**If contestants are sharing a horse and need to be split, it must be put on their entry forms!**

### ENTRY FEES

All speed events - \$25.00

All roping events - \$35.00

Goat tying - \$30.00

**DEADLINE:** Entries must be postmarked by March 13, 2023. Entries will be received until March 20, 2023 with a \$25.00 late fee.
