BMX Trickstars

A fair favorite returns in 2023! This team has a lineup of talent that reaches as high as a Gold Medal. They are class acts on and off the stage. It's amazing to see them perform as they pull off tricks that many would consider impossible. It's a must-see show...and generally draws some of the largest crowds. Performers feature brief verbal recognition of sponsor at each show, and there is written recognition as show sponsor.



Polka Dot Entertainment - Balloon Exhibit, Balloon Design, Strolling Act and More

Poppin' Penelope's exhibit starts from nothing and grows into a larger than life balloon wonderland. People will return every day to see what sprouted overnight. Every time she plants her balloon seeds the creation is different, from a 15' flamingo to a life sized Ferris wheel. The only limitation is her imagination! Penelope creates unique photo opportunities, social media buzz, and is a huge visual draw for newspapers and TV. Joined by husband Peter, he is an expert on stilts, at making balloons, and strolling entertainment.



Ninja Experience

The Ninja Experience offers highflying, jaw dropping, in your face action! Crowds will watch in amazement as these top athletes test their strength and agility on an intense obstacle course. Fairgoers become a part of the experience with hilarious audience participation and stunts that will have everyone on the edge of their seats.



Sea Lion Splash

The Sea Lion Splash is an entertaining and informative presentation that showcases the relationship between an "adopted family" of rescued sea lions and their handlers. Each of the sea lions being cared for by Sea Lion Splash LLC has been assigned to them by the National Marine Fisheries Service (informally known as NOAA Fisheries), a federal agency that is a division of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration. Sea Lion Splash LLC is fully licensed by NOAA Fisheries, the U.S. Department of Agriculture, and the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission. A huge hit at our 2022 fair, the Sea Lion Splash provided great entertainment for old and young alike!





Fireworks

The perfect ending to a perfect day! Help friends and families celebrate their fun filled day with a spectacular fireworks display on Friday and Saturday nights.



Mind Works!

A hands-on attraction offering STEM/STEAM-based activities which involve critical thinking, problem solving, and teamwork. Fairgoers can play games on giant boards such as Chess, Checkers, Connect Four, Battleship, Simon Says, Scrabble, Jenga, and Operation. They can build with magnets, giant foam blocks and wood blocks, or challenge their minds with chunky wood puzzles, or jumbo jigsaw puzzles. Fun for the entire family!



Historic Village

The Historic Village offers a historical display of items from the Bethesda Museum, as well as live demonstrations in wood carving, bobbin lace making, tatting and more. Many stories of the good old days are told, and people of all ages enjoy hearing about the vast history of Williamson County. We are proud and honored to showcase our county's history. Livestock Show Ring

Located in Barn "B", this centrally located barn is open to the fair going public to watch competitive livestock shows as they happen. Shows include, beef cattle, dairy goats, market goats, commercial ewes, and market lambs, as well as the 4-H Expo live auction.



Mobile Dairy Classroom

This 32-foot classroom features a fully operational milking parlor. It carries a live cow, milking equipment, and has a highly trained instructor that teaches the modern milking process, the importance of dairy foods in a healthy diet, animal care practices and much more.





Agriculture Exhibit

Located on the west end of the mezzanine in the indoor arena all Horticulture, Field Crops, Farm Eggs, Flowers, and Honey & Bees entries are on display, along with all the winning entries. Also located in this area are the Century Farms Exhibit, Pick TN Products Exhibit and Master Gardeners Exhibit.

Hometown Heroes

The Williamson County Fair honors veterans each year that have been nominated for the title of Hometown Hero. Whether they are a past or current member of the military they are nominated based on their achievements and/or service to the community that has gone unnoticed, and are honored on Patriot Day held the last Saturday of the fair.

Picnic Pavilion

Located indoors on the east end of the mezzanine, the Picnic Pavilion offers an area inside the air-conditioned arena for fairgoers to enjoy their "fair food". The pavilion is also used for several special events and competitive events throughout the 9 days of the fair, and before.



"Sign Your Heart Out" Vocal Competition

The "Sing Your Heart Out" vocal competition offers Elementary, Middle, and High School students an opportunity to compete for cash prizes, with the Overall Winner receiving an additional \$500 and other prizes. The contest will be held Tuesday, August 8th at 6:00 pm.



Ticket Booths - set of 2

Your company name will be one of the first things Fairgoers see as they enter at our ticket booths. A banner will be placed on the front of each booth. Sets of 2 include the main entrance booths (1 & 2), and the midway entrance booths (3 & 4). Offers nine (9) days of highly visible signage.





Birthing Pig Exhibit

This exhibit, located in Barn A - Little 1's Farming, offers the opportunity for fair visitors to view a mature, female pig in her later stages of gestation period, including the live birth of her many piglets. We never know how many babies we'll have, so it is always a big surprise!



Elevator Door Wraps - 1 door front and back

The elevator is located on the mezzanine just as you enter the main entrance of the arena. Your company logo/advertisement will have high visibility due to its location, and it is the only elevator in the building. Offers exposure on both sets of doors at the mezzanine level and the arena floor level.



Farmer Appreciation Night at the Fair

Help us honor our farming community. A new event in 2023, this will be held on Thursday, August 10th. Final plans for this evening are still in the works.



On-line Ticket Ad

In 2022, we sold over 32,500 tickets online. These pre-sale tickets are printed or shown on a phone for scanning at the ticket gate. All tickets may be printed for use of a coupon, which will drive business to your store or location. Tickets will have your company name, logo and coupon/ad located on the top right corner of the page.

Volunteer Appreciation Dinner

This dinner is held the night before opening day as a thank you and a kick off to the fair each year. Of the numerous volunteers that it takes to make the fair happen, around 250-300 attend the dinner each year in the Picnic Pavilion located in the air conditioned arena.



Your company name and/or logo will be placed on the back of printed tickets that will be given to each volunteer that works a minimum of 4 hours so that they may return to the fair another day and enjoy free admittance.

The Cultural Arts Exhibit showcases incredible talent in Fine Arts, Sustainable Arts, Photography, and Songwriting. All winning pieces are on display throughout the fair. The annual Community Art Project in also included in this exhibit where fairgoers are able to add their artistic touch to the design.



Glass Door Graphic Clings - 3 sets

Have your logo and business information on both the inside and outside of the doors leading into the arena. There are three separate sections of doors and clings would be placed at the bottom of every other door offering high visibility.



Hand Fans - choice of day

Hand fans will include your company name and logo, and may include a coupon or special to drive business to your store or location. These fans are handed out as patrons enter the fair on both Saturday's and on Sunday.



Hay Bale Decorating Contest

This contest is open to groups or teams and offers fun and creativity for all who participate. Bales are placed in various areas on the fairgrounds, decorated before the fair begins, and on display for the 9 days of the fair. Three winners are chosen and prize money is awarded.



Letters to Soldiers Post Office

3,445 letters have been collected and distributed to soldiers serving our country since our post office opened in 2017. We are grateful to all who have taken the time to write a letter to a soldier, and your sponsorship could help us send even more this year!



Pageants

Pageants are a highlight of most traditional Fairs, and the Williamson County Fair Pageant system helps young women across the county set goals for themselves while giving them confidence to achieve their dreams. The winner of the Fairest of the Fair competition represents Williamson County in the State Fairest of the Fair competition.

These tickets give you the opportunity to offer a coupon or special printed on each one sold. The same post and offer would be shared at 60 days out, then finally at 30 days out.
