Polka Dot Entertainment - Balloon Exhibit, Balloon Design, Strolling Act and More

Poppin' Penelope's exhibit starts from nothing and grows into a larger than life balloon wonderland. People will return every day to see what sprouted overnight. Every time she plants her balloon seeds the creation is different, from a 15' flamingo to a life sized Ferris wheel. The only limitation is her imagination! Penelope creates unique photo opportunities, social media buzz, and is a huge visual draw for newspapers and TV. Joined by husband Peter, he is an expert on stilts, at making balloons, and strolling entertainment.



<u>Sea Lion Splash</u>

The Sea Lion Splash is an entertaining and informative presentation that showcases the relationship between an "adopted family" of rescued sea lions and their handlers. Each of the sea lions being cared for by Sea Lion Splash LLC has been assigned to them by the National Marine Fisheries Service (informally known as NOAA Fisheries), a federal agency that is a division of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration. Sea Lion Splash LLC is fully licensed by NOAA Fisheries, the U.S. Department of Agriculture, and the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission. A huge hit at our fair the past two years, the Sea Lion Splash provides great entertainment for old and young alike!



The Amazing Wonderland Circus

Fair goers will be amazed by the ultimate displays of bravery on wheels! Daredevils perform aweinspiring stunts on the motorcycle globe of death and the colossal sky wheel of death. These breathtaking feats will leave the audience in awe as acrobats defy gravity to present a spectacular aerial display.

Whether they are a past or current member of the military they are nominated based on their achievements and/or service to the community that has gone unnoticed, and are honored on Patriot Day in a ceremony held the last Saturday of the fair.



Patriot Day

All active and retired military individuals are admitted FREE with military ID on the last Saturday of the Fair. Show your patriotic pride by having your business name on this day.



Picnic Pavilion

Located indoors on the east end of the mezzanine, the Picnic Pavilion offers an area inside the air-conditioned arena for fairgoers to enjoy their "fair food". The pavilion is also used for several special events and competitive events throughout the 9 days of the fair, and before.

The "Sing Your Heart Out" vocal competition offers Elementary, Middle, and High School students an opportunity to compete for cash prizes, with the Overall Winner receiving an additional \$500 and other prizes. The contest will be held Tuesday, August 6th at 6:00 pm.

On-line Ticket Ad

In 2023, we sold approximately 34,000 tickets online. These pre-sale tickets are printed or shown on a phone for scanning at the ticket gate. All tickets may be printed for use of a coupon, which will drive business to your store or location. Tickets will have your company name, logo and coupon/ad located on the top right corner of the page.



Utility Carts

Used by fair staff, volunteers, and public safety, these carts are utilized before, during, and after the fair. Signage will be prominently displayed on each cart .

Volunteer Appreciation Dinner

This dinner is held the night before opening day as a thank you and a kick off to the fair each year. Of the numerous volunteers that it takes to make the fair happen, around 250-300 attend the dinner each year in the Picnic Pavilion located in the air conditioned arena.

Volunteer Appreciation Tickets

The Cultural Arts Exhibit showcases incredible talent in Fine Arts, Sustainable Arts, and Photography. All winning pieces are on display throughout the fair. The annual Community Art Project is also included in this exhibit where fairgoers are able to add their artistic touch to the design.



<u>Floor Clings</u>

A 4' x 4' floor cling will be placed in a very prominent area on the mezzanine floor advertising your company for all 9 days of the fair.

Pageants

Pageants are a highlight of most traditional Fairs, and the Williamson County Fair Pageant system helps young women across the county set goals for themselves while giving them confidence to achieve their dreams. The winner of the Fairest of the Fair competition represents Williamson County in the State Fairest of the Fair competition, and we are proud to say that our own 2023 Fairest of the Fair, Laura Kennedy, was crowned 2nd runner-up in January, 2024.



Phone Charging Stations

A new section this year, "Tents on the Green" will be located outside in the northwest corner of the midway near food row. It will offer 10' x 10' spaces to a variety of vendors.

Participating food vendors offer one or more food items in small portions for \$3.00 each. This evening will be advertised before the fair on social media and other outlets, as well as the day of the event. #WilcoFair Bite Nite will be held on Wednesday, August 7th.



Youth Competitive Entry Exhibit

Located on the arena floor, all youth entries are on display, along with the winning entries. Highly visible to all fair goers, this year will include some hands-on activities that will draw more visitors to this area.

As of August, 2023 there are 40 certified Century Farms in Williamson County. The Century Farms Program recognizes farms owned by the same family for at least 100 years. These farms are among the most historic sites in the county and state, and they are celebrated each year with a special dinner at the fair. The dinner will be held Thursday, August 8th.



Cowboy Poetry

Cowboy poetry is rhymed, metered verse written by someone who has lived a significant portion of his or her life in Western North American cattle culture. The verse reflects an intimate knowledge of that way of life, and the community from which it maintains itself in tradition. This year we will introduce Middle Tennessee to this form of entertainment on Friday, August 9th on our new Pickin' Porch. This will be widely advertised and promoted.
