
### New Danville

In 2004, inspired by a mother's need to provide a safe, meaningful, fulfilling life for her disabled son, a group of community leaders from Montgomery County, Texas joined with her to establish Texas New Community Alliance (TNCA), a 501(c)3 charitable and educational organization. At the cornerstone of TNCA was the vision for a self-sustaining, master planned, integrated community where adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities ("IDD") could Live, Learn, Work, and Grow emotionally, socially, and spiritually with their non-disabled peers. That vision has become a reality with the development of New Danville.


## **Touch Base: Center For The Deaf Blind**

The purpose of this organization is to provide deafblind men and women with a day habilitation facility where they can participate in organized, meaningful, and purposeful activities. These individuals will attend the day hab with their interveners for four to six hours daily under the supervision of a program coordinator specialized in deafblindness. Each client will have a custom plan of activities and goals created by a team comprised of their guardian, intervener, and the program coordinator. They may use tactile calendars with symbols, cook their own meals, have an exercise regimen, and participate in different group projects. Additional activities offered will be pottery, candle-making, baking, etc. At Touch Base, we also hope to further the training of interveners and to create more awareness of deafblind people in the community.

#### 3. Waterford Crystal Chef of Chefs Competition Unprecedented Winners


Executive Chef, David Morris and Executive Pastry Chef, Ryan Witcher snagged both top chef awards for Robard's Steakhouse at last night's Wine & Food Week's Grand Tasting & Chef Showcase competition. In the festival's 14-year history, no other restaurant has ever won both awards in the same year. The achievement is unprecedented.



Chef David was awarded The Waterford Crystal Chef of Chefs Trophy and a \$5,000 cash prize for his Ménage à Trios Wagyus in the Woods dish, which featured a spectacular Miyazaki A5 Japanese Wagyu, Mishima Ranch Wagyu Short Rib, and Snake River Farms Wagyu Tenderloin with petit garden surprises, sunchoke purée, uni and foie butter with hollandaise and bordelaise syrup.



Chef Ryan was honored as the Just Desserts winner with a \$1,000 cash prize for his clever Texas Two-Step Donut Sundae comprised of homemade brioche donuts served with basil-infused Texas peaches and Rebecca Creek Whiskey Sauce topped with buttered Texas pecans.



#### 4. Mango Punch brought the fun with a huge conga line

Six-time winner of Houston's Best Latin Band, Mango Punch, had the crowd swinging and swaying to the music on the Wine Walk on Market Street.


