During your time with us, we want to assure you that the health of our guests, athletes, and team members is our top priority.



# What we ask of our valued guests:



Practice social distancing by leaving at least 6 feet between yourself, fellow guests, and/or staff members whenever possible



Wearing of facial coverings is **required** when not seated inside the restaurant or while not consuming food or beverages in the stands.



No loitering is permitted in the upper lobby area or restaurant. We ask that guests remain seated in the stands or wait outside.



No hockey bags or equipment may be left in the lobby area or taken into our restaurants.

# Additional measures we are taking during this time:

### **Locker Rooms**

We have enhanced our cleaning and disinfecting protocols, with particular attention paid to high-touch items, surfaces, and flooring.

### **Public Spaces**

We have increased the frequency of cleaning and disinfecting in public spaces, with a focus on the door handles, public bathrooms, and other high-touch surfaces.

### **Back of House**

In the spaces where team members work, we are increasing the frequency of cleaning and focusing on high-touch areas like restrooms, laundry facilities, and staff offices.

### **Protective Equipment**

You will see all team members wearing masks as mandated by state and local mandates.

### Hand Hygiene

Proper and frequent hand-washing is vital to help combat the spread of viruses. Our teams are reminded that cleanliness starts with this simple act. It's important for their health and that of our guests.

#### **Attendance: Number of Spectators**

Our attendance must be maintained at 20% of our normal level.

We are asking that no more than TWO (2) family members accompany a child who is participating.

### Locker Rooms

Locker room time is limited to 15 minutes before and after each game.

This is done to maximize social distancing, as well as provide adequate time for the staff to sanitize the locker rooms after each usage.

Showers are available for use. Please keep social distancing in mind.



## Equipment Bags

Equipment bags are allowed in the locker rooms, but players are encouraged to arrive at the rink dressed to play as much as possible.

As a reminder, no hockey bags or equipment may be left in the lobby area or taken into restaurant spaces.



# Mask Up

Masks or facial covers are required in all public spaces. This includes the locker room (while not showering) and on the ice.



## Attendance: Please Limit Your Time Before & After Games/Practices

Our attendance must be maintained at 20% of our normal level.

To meet that mandate, we have to limit time spent in the building. Please arrive no more than 15 minutes before your scheduled ice session and depart within 15 minutes after the completion of your session.



Mask Up Guests are required to wear a face covering when not seated at their table or bar top. If you stand up, please mask up.

### Please, No Loitering

Please stay in your seat unless visiting the restroom or heading out. No mingling between tables even if it's a really good story or a game recap, please catch up another time.
