

Wright County Fair FWD MiniVan Class 2024

FWD Mini Vans only allowed, (Caravan,Voyager, etc.) (No RW or AWD)

Vehicle must remain completely stock. This is meant to be a quick build class with no modifications or swapping of parts other than listed below.

The only welding allowed is drivers door, passenger door, differential, cage, and bumper attachment. Drivers door and passenger door may be fully welded on outside only.

May weld in a seat support bar and dash bar inside vehicle post to post. Inside door bars attached only to dash and seat bar on driver and passenger side. Floating cage only, no down bars.

May run aftermarket shifter, brake, and gas pedal setup, and steering column.

Strip vehicle as normal. No torching of fenders, no prebending of body panels, vehicle must be totally stock appearing. 12" hole in hood required for fire safety.

Electrical boxes may be relocated and simplified ignition harness may be used.

Original gas tank must be removed and a metal tank must be mounted securely and covered inside the vehicle. Tank and mounting must be safe or you will not run.

Battery must be moved inside of vehicle securely mounted away from any door and covered. Must be safe or you won't run.

Two chains allowed per vertical door seam. Four chains allowed for the hood. Rear hatch/door is allowed 4 total chains.

All suspension and struts must be stock. Two leaf springs clamps total per side. No chaining or welding of suspension.

You may run any tire on stock automotive rims. Valve stem protectors are allowed.

All airbags must be removed or disabled.

Front bumper can be a max of 4"x4" flat tube, or any automotive front bumper. No seam welding or plating of bumpers. Bumper may be welded directly to the frame with no added material for bumper attachment. Tube bumper cannot be loaded, the ends must remain open for inspection.

Pre run vans will be allowed to plate where van is bent. There must be proof of bend where plate is. Plate cannot exceed 5" x 5" x 1/4". Max of 4 plates per van.

Number must be painted in bright colors on both front doors and must be at least 15" tall. An upright sign with number must be used on the roof for identification of vehicle.

No objects, obscene words, or suggestions allowed on vehicle. They will be removed at judge's discretion!

No alterations allowed on vehicles after inspection, you may be disqualified.

Vehicles may be subject to reinspection at any time.

Don't assume anything – call first. Must know your vehicle type, model, and which class you are in. No welders allowed in pit.
