- ⇒ The processor will contact you for cut & wrap instructions and to schedule pickup when ready. A cut and wrap fee will be added to your auction invoice.
- ⇒ Small Animals: Chuck's Custom (Dixon) We will contact you to pickup in Woodland

For Service Clubs · Host a BBQ, donate the meat, auction off at a fundraiser event to boost the club's treasury!

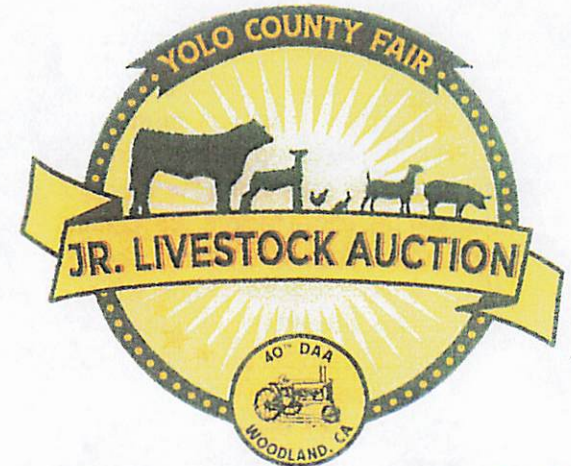

The Bottom Line

The cost of a 4-H or FFA animal project is higher than that of commercially produced livestock because of the added initial costs of purchasing a stock show quality animal and the individual attention given to that animal's development. Jr members dedicate hundreds of hours caring for their project while learning valuable life skills along the way. These economic and beneficial factors associated with the livestock project deserve a premium price. The price paid above the "break even" cost will allow the exhibitor to earn a profit margin that can be reinvested into next year's project and/or saved for future educational expenses.

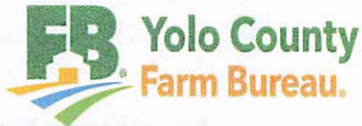

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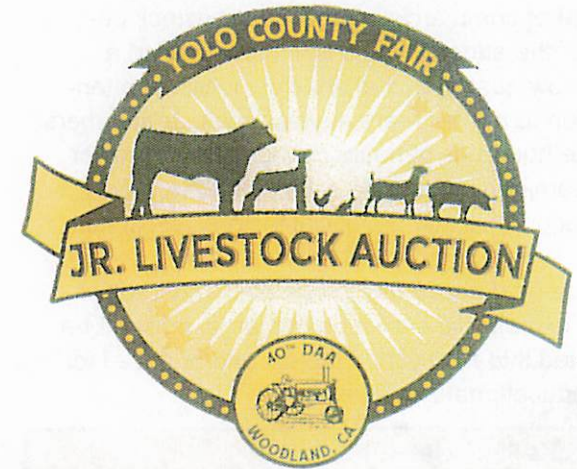
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
