Environmental Quality Incentives Program

- NRCS' primary program for helping producers implement conservation practices on their land.
- Provides financial and technical assistance to address natural resource concerns.
- Benefits include:
 - Improving air, soil and water quality
 - Conserving water and energy, saving money
 - Preventing soil erosion
 - Enhancing on-farm wildlife habitat
 - Mitigating impacts from climate change

Conservation Practices

- Structural, vegetative, and management practices that producers can implement to conserve natural resources.
- Most commonly used practices in Yolo County:
 - Microirrigation systems w/ soil moisture sensors
 - Cover crop
 - Whole orchard recycling
 - Compost or mulch
 - Hedgerow planting
 - Tractor/equipment replacement
 - Livestock watering systems
