Scholarship Application

The Yolo County Young Farmers and Ranchers group annually awards scholarships to Yolo County high school seniors or local college students who are pursuing degrees in Agriculture and related fields. Since 2010, the Young Farmers and Ranchers have awarded over \$20,000 in scholarships. Each year, the Young Farmers and Ranchers award anywhere from one to five scholarships. Scholarship amounts vary each year from \$1,000-\$5,000.

YF&R Scholarship Application Instructions

***Please read all instructions carefully, incomplete applications will not be considered.**

- 1) Eligible applicants include graduating high school seniors or current college students.
- 2) All applicants must currently reside in Yolo County.
- 3) All applications must be typed.
- 4) Applications must be postmarked by **June 2, 2023**.
- 5) Applications must be submitted in a sealed envelope and either mailed to the Farm Bureau or dropped off by the applicant. Emailed applications will not be considered. Address applications to:

- 6) Applications must include an unofficial transcript from applicant's high school or college.
- 7) All applicants must list participation in school activities, awards and achievements, community involvement, and work experience.
- 8) All applicants must submit two current letters of recommendation. College students need to submit one letter from a college professor and one from a reference outside of their college. Letters must be signed and dated by person providing reference.
- 9) Applicants must be planning to attend a two year community college, four year college or university, or a career technical program, and is majoring in an agriculture based or related field.
- 10) Award preference will be given to first time applicants, applicants showing financial need, and applicants studying an agriculture or related field.
- 11) Late applications will not be considered.
- 12) Successful award recipients will be required to submit official documentation signed by the school's registrar confirming enrollment in college. Scholarship funds will not be released until this is information submitted. Such documentation must include the recipient's student ID number.
- 13) Scholarships will be mailed directly to the college's financial department to be used towards tuition.
