GRANDSTAND INFORMATION

- All Grandstand tickets include admission to the fair when redeemed at the entrance gates.
- During the fair, tickets may be purchased at Will Call under the Grandstand or at the ticket window located outside the Administration Office near Gate 1.
- We recommend that guests arrive at least 45 minutes prior to the event start time and bring only essential items into the venue.
- There will be NO concert entrance underneath the Grandstand.
- The main concert entrance is located at the east end of the track, directly across from Kiddie Kingdom.
- The ADA concert entrance remains between the Grandstand and the Annex.
- Concerts are held rain or shine.
- No outside beverages permitted.
- No umbrellas.
- Regular parking charges apply.

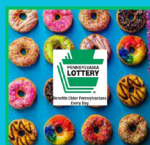

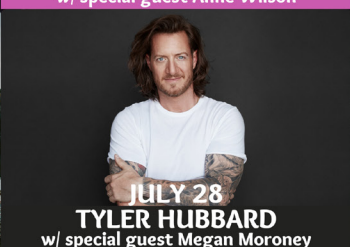

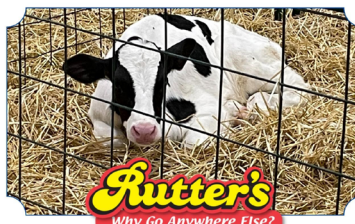
