GENERAL INFORMATION

PARKING RULES

- Automobiles and all other vehicles must be parked on space assigned by the Parking Department. All vehicles improperly parked will be towed away.
- Under no circumstances can automobiles be parked around buildings, in fire lanes, or in open areas throughout the central part of the grounds.
- Livestock trailer/truck parking in assigned areas. Camper parking in assigned areas with permit only. See Livestock Office.
- The Society will not be liable, under any circumstances, through negligence of itself, its agents, acts of third party, or otherwise, for injury to the person or property of the owner or occupant, for any property loss or damage.

GENERAL RULES

- 1. All rules and regulations referred to herein are made a part of the conditions under which entries are accepted and permits granted for exhibits and concessions.
- 2. The Management reserves the right to interpret, amend or add to its rules and regulations.
- 3. Persons violating general, special rules or engaging in personal misconduct shall be subject to such penalty as the management may impose including forfeiture of all privileges and premiums.
- 4. The management encourages the reporting of mistreatment or extortion by concessionaires and any discourtesy or irregularity of its employees. Violation of local, State or Federal laws should be reported promptly to the Police Department.
- 5. No pets, except properly identified service animals and properly identified service animals-in-training will be allowed anywhere on the fairgrounds. All service animals must remain leashed. Dogs, whether leashed or not, are prohibited on the grounds.

EXHIBITS AND EXHIBITORS

Read carefully all rules pertaining to each department.

- 1. Applications for entries of Livestock must be made on forms furnished by the Society in accordance with instructions and rules of the premium list.
- 2. Right is reserved to close entries before specified closing date. Entries cannot be changed after closing date. NO REFUNDS.
- 3. Entries must be made in the name of a bona fide owner. Violation of this rule shall work a forfeiture of premiums.
- 4. All livestock must stay in the designated area.
- 5. The Management has the right to require any unhealthy animal to be removed from the Fair Grounds.
- 6. All livestock entries (except steers, market goats, & companion goats) must be registered with their National Breed Association. Hereford cattle must be in the American Polled Hereford Association Record and or The American Hereford Assoc. All animals must have clearly legible tattoo identification and such identity must conform to the tattoo recorded on the official registry certificates.
- 7. All exhibits must be delivered and removed at time indicated by rules of each department.
- 8. Exhibits must be displayed in the manner requested by Department Superintendents.
- 9. All livestock must be judged in order to be eligible for premiums.
- 10. Any exhibitor removing any of their animals from the barn before the release time will forfeit all their premium money.
- 11. The posting and distribution of advertising matter is strictly prohibited other than in or from space occupied by exhibitor.
- 12. The Management assumes no responsibility for loss or damage to stock or exhibits from any cause.
- 13. The Management will take every precaution to protect the safety of stock or articles entered or shown after their arrival and placement; but under no circumstances will it be responsible for any loss, injury or damage done to, or occasioned by, or arising from any animal or article on exhibition. The exhibitor shall indemnify the York County Agricultural Society for any and all damages caused by any animal or article.
- 14. The Society reserves the right to withhold awards where its rules and regulations are not complied with, where fraud or deception has been practiced, or where the exhibit does not merit an award.
- 15. Fair reserves the right to reject or disqualify any entry. In all cases, the decision of the management shall be final.
- 16. False representation, interference or misconduct by an exhibitor or his agent will be dealt with by the Director in Charge of the departments wherein the exhibit is entered. There will be no appeal from this decision.
- 17. Protests against awards must be in writing and indicate the reason there for and be filed with the Secretary not later than the day after the award is made. Protestants will be granted a hearing if deemed necessary, by the Management.
- 18. Payment of premiums will be made by check.
- 19. Premium checks must be cashed within 30 days. Deadline for reporting any discrepancies in award checks is September 30th, 2024.

JUDGES

- 1. Exhibitors are not permitted to act as judges in a class in which he or she exhibits or is directly or indirectly interested.
- 2. Judges must not award prizes to an unworthy exhibit. In the absence of competition, or where only one exhibit is entered, 1st, 2nd, 3rd or no premiums will be awarded according to the merit of the exhibit.
- 3. Judges will make special mention of meritorious exhibits for which no premium is offered.
- 4. Interference with judges will not be permitted. Interfering exhibitors will be barred from competition.
- 5. All award books or sheets must be properly signed by the judges and returned to the head of the department immediately after the completion of awards.
- 6. In paying premiums, no evidence of awards will be recognized except the entry book and sheets, signed by superintendents and judges. Ribbons, cards, and labels that may be attached to the exhibits will not be recognized.
- 7. The decision of the judges will be final in all cases except where error, fraud, misrepresentation or collusion, not discovered at the time of the award, is proven. In such cases, the decision of the Management will be final.

DEPARTMENT 8 & 9 POULTRY, PIGEONS, RABBITS, AND CAVIES

Kellye Shue, Poultry & Pigeons Julie Inch, Rabbits & Cavies

Poultry, Pigeon, Rabbit & Cavy Rules & Information:

- 1. No person shall handle exhibits without the permission of the superintendent or owners of the exhibit. These rules will be strictly enforced.
- 2. After receipt of all entries by Friday, July 19th at 11 AM, building will be open 11:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., Friday thru Sunday and 12:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Monday thru Thursday.
- 3. Entries will be received until July 5th, 2024 or such time as the cooping capacity is reached.
- 4. Only entered listed specimens will be accepted.
- 5. Entered specimens will be received on, Thursday, July 18th from 1:00 P.M. to 8:00 P.M. and on Friday, July 19th from 8:00 A.M. to 11:00 A.M. Entries released Sunday, July 28th from 6:00 P.M. to 9:00 P.M.
 - a. Removal of ANY animals prior to this time will result in the forfeiture of awards unless prior approval is received from the poultry or rabbit superintendent.
- 6. ALL animals will be shown in the John Paige Smith Building.
- 7. USE GATE #'s 5 & 8 Pearl Street and Highland Avenue for Entrance
- 8. Applications and fees for entries will be received in person, by mail or online at the office of the Society, 334 Carlisle Ave., York, PA 17404. Checks or money orders payable to the York County Agricultural Society.
- 9. All department judging starts Monday, July 22th, at 8:00 A.M. or when departments are ready.
- 10. A judge shall not officiate in a class where he has an entry. Collusion between a judge and exhibitor will exclude from competition and awards all entries of the offending exhibitor. Exhibitor's protest relative to such exclusion must be in writing.
- 11. Specimens are entered at the sole risk of the owner. The Management will take the greatest possible care of all exhibits but will not be responsible for accident, mistake, loss or damage thereto. All entries will be watered, fed and cared for by competent employees.
- 12. Entered specimens must be bona fide property of exhibitor.
- 13. Entries showing physical evidence of transmissible disease will be excluded from the show. During the continuance of the show, all entries will be examined carefully each day. Entries showing signs of disease will be segregated and properly cared for or returned to the owner at his expense.
- 14. Substitutions will be permitted before closing date of the entries. No substitutions will be permitted after closing date of entries unless of the same breed, variety and sex.
- 15. Names, distinctive marks, advertising or decorations will not be permitted until all judging and awards are completed in that department, i.e., poultry, pigeon, or rabbit & cavy department.
- 16. During judging rabbits, cavies, poultry & pigeons will be handled only by the judge or authorized Fair Official, or owner
- 17. Entries will be accepted and premiums paid only on breeds, varieties and colors listed in the York State Fair Premium book and will be awarded only on animals or birds exhibited in their proper classes.
- 18. In the absence of a protest, which must be in writing, the decision of the judges will be final.
- 19. Premiums will be paid only on awards indicated by judges' records.
- 20. Any contingency that may arise and is not covered by these rules will be adjusted by the Department Superintendent whose action will be final.
- 21. All **Animal Health Requirements** must be followed.

DEPARTMENT 9- OPEN RABBITS RABBITS GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

- 1. Entry Fee: \$1.00 per rabbit.
 - a. The fee must be paid at the time entries are submitted.
- 2. Entries will be received until July 5th, 2024 or such time as the cooping capacity is reached.
- 3. All entries are subject to General Rules.
- 4. Entered specimens will be received on, Thursday, July 18th from 1:00 P.M. to 8:00 P.M. and on Friday, July 19th from 8:00 A.M. to 11:00 A.M. Entries released Sunday, July 28th from 6:00 P.M. to 9:00 P.M.
 - a. Removal of animals prior to this time will result in the forfeiture of awards unless prior approval is received from the building superintendent.
- 5. Each exhibitor is required to submit a VCPR to the Rabbit Superintendent at check-in.
 - a. The VCPR Form can be found at the end of the PPRC Catalog.
- 6. Judging will take place Monday, July 22th at 8:00 A.M.
- 7. All specimens will compete in various classes. Any animal that has COD by it's variety is allowed to exhibit for judging comments. Any breeds that are COD will not be included in Best In Show consideration.
- 8. **All rabbits must have permanent earmarks.** Tattooing done by Fair personnel charge \$1.00. We will honor ear # requests if possible otherwise, tattoo numbers will be assigned by Fair Show Secretary. Tattoo is done by hand clamp tattoo.
- 9. The Judges will award First, Second, & Third Places. An Official Sticker will be placed on the coop card.
- 10. The show rules and standards of the American Rabbit and Cavies Breeders' Association, Inc., will be in force throughout the show, an entry there under indicates acceptance of these rules.
- 11. This is an official show of the American Rabbit Breeders Association, Inc.
- 12. Substitution allowed only in same breed, color, class and sex.

Animal Health Regulations

Section 15: Pennsylvania Rabbits

Requirements:

- 1.Each exhibitor is required to submit a VCPR to the Rabbit Superintendent at check-in.
 - o The VCPR Form can be found at the end of the PPRC Catalog.
- 2. The Department of Agriculture has no specific requirements for Pennsylvania rabbits at fairs.
- 3. The owner of the animal and the place of exhibition or destination shall meet the standards established at sections 2323 and 2327 of the Domestic Animal Law (3 PA.C.S. 2323 and 2327) and set forth in Supchapter A, paragraphs 9 and 10 of this document.
- 4. The owner of the animal shall meet all general requirements for importations and intrastate movement as set forth in sections 3.3, 3.4, 3.5, 3.6, and 3.7 of the Department's regulations (7 Pa.Code 3.3-3.7).
- 5. While on exhibit or at any time following exhibition, you are obligated to report all mass mortality events and all rabbits who are ill and bleeding from eyes, nose, mouth, or have bloody stools to the department emergency line 717-772-2852 option 1. We need your help to quickly identify and stop dangerous transmissible diseases such as Rabbit Hemorrhagic Disease Type 2 (RHDV-2) from spreading.

DEPARTMENT 9- RABBITS Animal Health Regulations

Section 15: Pennsylvania Rabbits-Continued

Recommendations:

- 1. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued with 14 days of exhibition of the fair with the following statements:
 - a. "All Rabbits in the shipment have been examined for and found free of infectious, contagious or communicable diseases including RHDV-2 and there have not been multiple mortality events or rabbits exhibiting hemorrhages within the last 90 days. The rabbits in this shipment have not been housed or exhibited with any rabbits associated with known mass mortality or hemorrhage events."
 - b. "In the last 90 days, the rabbits in the shipment, have not been exhibited in, housed in, or traveled to, any state or territory in which RHDV-2 has been diagnosed within the last 12 months. In addition, during the last 90 days, they have had no contact with any captive or wild rabbit originating from or travelled to one of those affected states or territories."

Section 16: Out of State Rabbits

Requirements:

- 1. Each exhibitor is required to submit a VCPR to the Rabbit Superintendent at check-in.
 - a. The VCPR Form can be found at the end of the PPRC Catalog.
- 2.Interstate and International Order of Quarantine: The owner and the exhibition or destination shall comply with the requirements of the Department's quarantine order, "Interstate/International Order; Rabbit Hemorrhagic Disease [50 Pa.B.5272, Saturday, September 26, 2020].
- 3. Rabbits originating from a Commonwealth, State, Territory or Country Identified as being affected by RHD within the 12 months prior to the start of the exhibition:
 - a. No rabbits or their products, such as meat, pelts, hides, carcasses or other items, and no equipment, exposed feed, forages, or conveyances or other items or associated materials may enter the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania from a Commonwealth, State, Territory, or Country where Rabbit Hemorrhagic Disease (RHD) has been diagnosed in the prior twelve (12) months or there is a reasonable suspicion it exists unless they meet the following requirements:
 - i. All live rabbits must be accompanied by an CVI and must be examined by an accredited veterinarian within the seventy-two (72) hours prior to the date of shipment to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The CVI must include statements by an accredited veterinarian certifying that:
 - 1. All rabbits in the shipment have been examined for and found free of infectious, contagious or communicable diseases:
 - 2. All rabbits have originated from a single premises that has no signs of infectious, contagious or communicable disease in rabbits;
 - 3. There have been no movements of rabbits onto the premises of origin with the 90 days prior to the date of the shipment; and
 - 4. The rabbits have had no contact with wild or captive rabbits other than their cohorts in the 90 days prior to the date of shipment.
 - ii. No rabbits or their products, such as, meat pelts, hides, carcasses or other items, and no equipment, exposed feed or conveyances or other items or associated material may enter the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania from a premises exposed to, contaminated with or known to be affected with RHD, or where there is a reasonable suspicion the disease exists or the rabbits have been exposed to or infected with RHD.

Recommendations:

- 1. For all rabbits: Vaccination against RHDV-2 is encouraged. PLEASE NOTE: Vaccination of rabbits does not exempt the rabbit, rabbit products, or equipment used for them, from meeting the import requirement set forth in the Department's "Interstate/International Quarantine Order; Rabbit Hemorrhagic Disease [50 Pa.B. 5272, Saturday, September 26, 2020] and listed in subsections 1. 1. and 2. (relating to requirements) above.
- 2. For rabbits that originate from a from a Commonwealth, State, Territory, or Country where RHDV-2 has NOT been diagnosed in the prior twelve (12) months or there is NO reasonable suspicion it exists:
 - a. Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI): It is highly recommended that fairs and exhibitions ask that each exhibited rabbit be listed on an interstate CVI written within 14 days of entrance. The Certificate of Veterinary inspection shall be written by an accredited veterinarian and contain the following statements:
 - i. "All Rabbits in the shipment have been examined for and found free of infectious, contagious or communicable diseases including RHDV-2 and there have not been multiple mortality events or rabbits exhibiting hemorrhages within the last 90 days. The rabbits in this shipment have not been housed or exhibited with any rabbits associated with known mass mortality or hemorrhage events."
 - ii. "In the last 90 days, the rabbits in the shipment, have not been exhibited in, housed in, or traveled to, any state or territory in which RHDV-2 has been diagnosed within the last 12 months. In addition, during the last 90 days, they have had no contact with any captive or wild rabbit originating from or travelled to one of those affected states or territories."

DEPARTMENT 11-9- YOUTH RABBITS RABBITS GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION


- 1. Department 11 is open to all youth under 19 years old.
 - a. Exhibitor must not have reached their 19th birthday to enter!
- 2. Youth are subject to the same General Rules as Department 9.
- 3. This department has been set up to provide all youth in Pennsylvania an opportunity to participate at the fair. Youth may enter the same animal in both the Open and Youth Departments.
- 4. Entries will be received until July 5th, 2024 or such time as the cooping capacity is reached.
- 5. All entries are subject to General Rules & Animal Health Regulations.
- 6. Entered specimens will be received on, Thursday, July 18th from 1:00 P.M. to 8:00 P.M. and on Friday, July 19th from 8:00 A.M. to 11:00 A.M. Entries released Sunday, July 28th from 6:00 P.M. to 9:00 P.M.
 - a. Removal of animals prior to this time will result in the forfeiture of awards unless prior approval is received from the building superintendent.
- 7. Each exhibitor is required to submit a VCPR to the Rabbit Superintendent at check-in.
 - a. The VCPR Form can be found at the end of the PPRC Catalog.
- 8. Judging will take place Monday, July 22th at 8:00 A.M.
- 9. All specimens will compete in various classes. Any animal that has COD by it's variety is allowed to exhibit for judging comments. Any breeds that are COD will not be included in Best In Show consideration.
- 10. **All rabbits must have permanent earmarks.** Tattooing can be done by Fair personnel charge \$1.00. Tattoo Numbers assigned by Fair Show Secretary. Will accommodate requests if possible. Tattoos are done by clamp tattoo.
- 11. The Judges will award First, Second, & Third Places. An Official Sticker will be placed on the coop card.
- 12. The show rules and standards of the American Rabbit and Cavies Breeders' Association, Inc., will be in force throughout the show, an entry there under indicates acceptance of these rules.
- 13. This is an official show of the American Rabbit Breeders Association, Inc.
- 14. Substitution allowed only in same breed, color, class and sex.

DEPARTMENT 11-9- YOUTH RABBITS Animal Health Regulations

Section 15: Pennsylvania Rabbits

Requirements:

- 1. Each exhibitor is required to submit a VCPR to the Rabbit Superintendent at check-in.
 - o The VCPR Form can be found at the end of the PPRC Catalog.
- 2. The Department of Agriculture has no specific requirements for Pennsylvania rabbits at fairs.
- 3. The owner of the animal and the place of exhibition or destination shall meet the standards established at sections 2323 and 2327 of the Domestic Animal Law (3 PA.C.S. 2323 and 2327) and set forth in Supchapter A, paragraphs 9 and 10 of this document.
- 4. The owner of the animal shall meet all general requirements for importations and intrastate movement as set forth in sections 3.3, 3.4, 3.5, 3.6, and 3.7 of the Department's regulations (7 Pa.Code 3.3-3.7).
- 5. While on exhibit or at any time following exhibition, you are obligated to report all mass mortality events and all rabbits who are ill and bleeding from eyes, nose, mouth, or have bloody stools to the department emergency line 717-772-2852 option 1. We need your help to quickly identify and stop dangerous transmissible diseases such as Rabbit Hemorrhagic Disease Type 2 (RHDV-2) from spreading.

Recommendations:

- 1.A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued with 14 days of exhibition of the fair with the following statements:
 - a. "All Rabbits in the shipment have been examined for and found free of infectious, contagious or communicable diseases including RHDV-2 and there have not been multiple mortality events or rabbits exhibiting hemorrhages within the last 90 days. The rabbits in this shipment have not been housed or exhibited with any rabbits associated with known mass mortality or hemorrhage events."
 - b. "In the last 90 days, the rabbits in the shipment, have not been exhibited in, housed in, or traveled to, any state or territory in which RHDV-2 has been diagnosed within the last 12 months. In addition, during the last 90 days, they have had no contact with any captive or wild rabbit originating from or travelled to one of those affected states or territories."

Section 16: Out of State Rabbits

Requirements:

- 1. Each exhibitor is required to submit a VCPR to the Rabbit Superintendent at check-in.
 - a. The VCPR Form can be found at the end of the PPRC Catalog.
- Interstate and International Order of Quarantine: The owner and the exhibition or destination shall comply with the requirements of the Department's quarantine order, "Interstate/International Order; Rabbit Hemorrhagic Disease [50 Pa.B.5272, Saturday, September 26, 2020].
- 3. Rabbits originating from a Commonwealth, State, Territory or Country Identified as being affected by RHD within the 12 months prior to the start of the exhibition:
 - a. No rabbits or their products, such as meat, pelts, hides, carcasses or other items, and no equipment, exposed feed, forages, or conveyances or other items or associated materials may enter the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania from a Commonwealth, State, Territory, or Country where Rabbit Hemorrhagic Disease (RHD) has been diagnosed in the prior twelve (12) months or there is a reasonable suspicion it exists unless they meet the following requirements:
 - i. All live rabbits must be accompanied by an CVI and must be examined by an accredited veterinarian within the seventy-two (72) hours prior to the date of shipment to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The CVI must include statements by an accredited veterinarian certifying that:
 - All rabbits in the shipment have been examined for and found free of infectious, contagious or communicable diseases;
 - 2. All rabbits have originated from a single premises that has no signs of infectious, contagious or communicable disease in rabbits;
 - 3. There have been no movements of rabbits onto the premises of origin with the 90 days prior to the date of the shipment; and
 - 4. The rabbits have had no contact with wild or captive rabbits other than their cohorts in the 90 days prior to the date of shipment.
 - ii. No rabbits or their products, such as, meat pelts, hides, carcasses or other items, and no equipment, exposed feed or conveyances or other items or associated material may enter the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania from a premises exposed to, contaminated with or known to be affected with RHD, or where there is a reasonable suspicion the disease exists or the rabbits have been exposed to or infected with RHD.

Recommendations:

- 1. For all rabbits: Vaccination against RHDV-2 is encouraged. PLEASE NOTE: Vaccination of rabbits does not exempt the rabbit, rabbit products, or equipment used for them, from meeting the import requirement set forth in the Department's "Interstate/International Quarantine Order; Rabbit Hemorrhagic Disease [50 Pa.B. 5272, Saturday, September 26, 2020] and listed in subsections 1. 1. and 2. (relating to requirements) above.
- 2. For rabbits that originate from a from a Commonwealth, State, Territory, or Country where RHDV-2 has NOT been diagnosed in the prior twelve (12) months or there is NO reasonable suspicion it exists:
 - a. Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI): It is highly recommended that fairs and exhibitions ask that each exhibited rabbit be listed on an interstate CVI written within 14 days of entrance. The Certificate of Veterinary inspection shall be written by an accredited veterinarian and contain the following statements.

Recommendations-Continued:

- i. "All Rabbits in the shipment have been examined for and found free of infectious, contagious or communicable diseases including RHDV-2 and there have not been multiple mortality events or rabbits exhibiting hemorrhages within the last 90 days. The rabbits in this shipment have not been housed or exhibited with any rabbits associated with known mass mortality or hemorrhage events."
- ii. "In the last 90 days, the rabbits in the shipment, have not been exhibited in, housed in, or traveled to, any state or territory in which RHDV-2 has been diagnosed within the last 12 months. In addition, during the last 90 days, they have had no contact with any captive or wild rabbit originating from or travelled to one of those affected states or territories."

 - a. Removal of animals prior to this time will result in the forfeiture of awards unless prior approval is received from the building superintendent.
- 7. Judging will take place Monday, July 22th at 8:00 A.M.
- 8. All specimens will compete in various classes.
- 9. **All cavies must have permanent ear tags.** Tagging can be done by Fair personnel charge \$1.00. It is highly recommended however to have cavy tagged prior to check-in day to help expedite the check-in process.
- 10. The Judges will award First, Second, & Third Places. An Official Sticker will be placed on the coop card.
- 11. The show rules and standards of the American Rabbit and Cavies Breeders' Association, Inc. will be in force throughout the show, and entry there under indicates acceptance of these rules.

Department 11-22-6-1 Youth Rabbit Agility

Show Time: Thursday, July 25th, 2024, 5:00 P.M.

General Rules:

- 1. The rabbit and handler are considered a team. Exhibitor may not hand their rabbit over to anyone else during competition to compete in other events.
- 2. Hopping rabbits **DO NOT** have to be entered in the show to compete, but all RHD and health regulations apply and the York State Fair reserves the right to check animals and ask for their removal, if ill.
- 3. All rabbits must be at least 4 months of age to compete.
- 4. The rabbit must comply with all general rules and requirements listed in the 2024 YSF PPRC catalog.
- 5. The rabbit needs to be properly socialized able to move freely, meaning the rabbit needs to be structurally sound: free of physical abnormalities and injury, as well as not overweight.
- 6. If the rabbit is pregnant or nursing babies, she cannot compete.
- 7. All and any mistreatment of a rabbit will not be tolerated.
- 8. If the rabbit is out of its carrier or cage, it must never be left unattended or tied up in the competition area.
- 9. The rabbit must hop through the course at their own free will. Handlers may encourage or guide their rabbits forward vocally (softly) or with gentle touches/tickles.

Handlers:

- 1. During the event, exhibitors clothing should be clean and neat in appearance. Jeans are acceptable and should have no tears or holes in them. No flip flops or sandals are permitted.
- 2. You may not jump the jumps and/or walk over or through any equipment with your rabbit.
- 3. You are responsible for repairing or replacing any damaged or wrecked equipment because of your actions.
- 4. You should bring your own rabbit to the hopping course for competition.
- 5. You may use voice commands or hand commands, to guide your rabbit through the course. Handlers will be allowed to touch their rabbits to encourage them to move, with your voice or gentle touches by your hands. No directing with feet.
- 6. You are encouraged to talk to and cheer your rabbit on as he or she does the course, but do not scream at your rabbit.

Department 11-22-6-1 Youth Rabbit Agility

Handlers-Continued:

- 7. Do not drag your rabbit through, onto or over a jump by its leash.
- 8. You are encouraged to talk to and cheer your rabbit on as he or she does the course, but do not scream at your rabbit.
- 9. Do not drag your rabbit through, onto or over a jump by its leash.

Rabbit Equipment:

- 1. Harnesses must be plain, flat "H" style harness. The harness needs to be loose enough not to restrict the rabbit's movement, but not let the rabbit slip out of the harness.
- 2. Leashes must be between 4 and 6 feet long depending on the size of the competitor.
- 3. Leashes and harnesses not meeting safety standards for rabbits will not be allowed to be used on the rabbit.
- 4. No treats (for the exhibitor or rabbit) will be allowed on the hopping course.
- 5. You will be told what the course will be before you compete.

General Competition:

- 1. Leashes need to be held at all times.
- 2. You are responsible for cleaning up after your rabbit. Cleaning equipment will be available for disinfecting and cleaning equipment if your rabbits make messes on the course.
- 3. Your rabbit will be allowed three tries at any jump before the judge will ask you to place the rabbit over the jump.
- 4. If the rabbit leaves the course, it is not a penalty as long as the rabbit re-enters the course at the point where it left within the time limit.
- 5. The rabbit must finish the course or it will be disqualified.
- 6. The rabbit has completed the course when on two different instances the rabbit has been able to complete all of the jumps on the course without elimination.
- 7. Course direction will be announced at the start of the class by the Judge.

Class 1. Beginner: straight line course

5 to 6 jumps include start and finish jump.

- Maximum Height 10" Minimum Height 4"

- 6 faults allowed
- Distance between each jump is 6 feet
- 4 points must be earned in "Advanced Class

Department 10-9- Rabbit Showmanship Show Time: Monday, July 22th, 2024

Barn checks may be conducted for every member participating in this project as deemed necessary by 4-H leaders and Extension Staff to ensure members are making progress with their projects.
- 2. Exhibitors must notify their 4-H leader or FFA advisor by **APRIL 1**ST of their intent to show a Market Pen at the York State Fair. Exhibitors must enter their Market Pen though the York State Fair online entry system or by mail, pay close attention to the entry due date as this is a closed entry show.
 - a. Each entry should be entered under **Division 10-09-4-H & FFA Meat Rabbits**.
- 3. An entry form must be sent to the York State Fair or submitted online by July 5th, 2024.
- 4. You must own the doe(s) by April 1st and kit's must be kindled in the owner's rabbitry. Plan to breed your does 100 days or less from the day of the show but not before **APRIL 10TH**, **2024** (100 days before the start of the York State Fair)
- 5. All rabbits must be tattooed prior to the fair and in the presence of a York County 4-H Rabbit and Small Animal Club leader, FFA advisor or a York County Extension Agent. Exhibitors may tattoo up to ten rabbits but may only show their top three rabbits at the Fair. The tattoo date for 2024 is to be determined by the York Co 4-H office.
- 6. Members may only show and sell rabbits younger than 69 days old as of the check in at the York State Fair.
- 7. All rabbits must be accepted ARBA breeds and EACH rabbit in the Meat Pen (consisting of three rabbits) MUST weigh between at least 3 ½ pounds and no more than 5 ½ pounds at York State Fair check in. Ideal average weight is 5 pounds.
- 8. Premiums will be awarded as such:

<u>Section 13: Pennsylvania Poultry, Unfertilized Eggs, and Ornamental Feathers</u> Requirements:

- 1. Changes for exhibition of poultry and poultry products in 2024 if the Department has determined that there are currently no active HPAI control areas or surveillance zones in place in Pennsylvania, and at the Department's discretion:
 - a. The 2024 Animal Health Requirements and Recommendations for Animal Exhibition, Including Commercial Exhibition, will reference the April 16, 2022 General Quarantine Order; Cancellation of Exhibition of Poultry and Their Hatching Eggs Due to Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza or its successor Order, which may allow for limited exhibition of poultry and poultry products at venues that receive funding pursuant to the Pennsylvania Agricultural Fair Act referenced above, if the Department has determined that there are currently no active HPAI control areas or surveillance zones in place in Pennsylvania.
 - b. If the Department has determined that there are currently no active HPAI control areas or surveillance zones in place in Pennsylvania, the exhibition of market poultry which will be moved directly to slaughter may be allowed, at the Department's discretion. The Department will provide notification to fair managers if any active HPAI control areas or surveillance zones are in place in Pennsylvania at the beginning of the 2024 fair season and will provide updates throughout the season as necessary. The placement of a HPAI control area or surveillance zone in Pennsylvania will result in the immediate reinstatement of the prohibition of exhibition for all poultry and all poultry products.
- No poultry exhibitions regardless of their funding, association or venue may occur within a 10km control area of a premise infected with Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza. Poultry exhibitions may occur at venues or locations that are not within a current control area and do not receive funding pursuant to the Pennsylvania Agricultural Fair Act.

DEPARTMENT 10-08 4-H & FFA MEAT POULTRY Animal Health Regulations

<u>Section 13: Pennsylvania Poultry, Unfertilized Eggs, and Ornamental Feathers</u> Requirements- Continued:

3. Requirements for Exhibition of Market Poultry:

- a. All Pennsylvania poultry entering an exhibition must bear an official Department issued leg band. Ratites must be identified with a neck band or an electronic implant device (exhibitor must supply a reader).
- b. Poultry may be exhibited only if they will be moved immediately after judging directly from the fair/show grounds to a facility for slaughter. All poultry exhibited in Pennsylvania at Department sponsored or funded exhibitions shall move as all-in and all-out directly to a Department of USDA licensed slaughter facility following the animal exhibition and may not be diverted to premises other than a recognized slaughter establishment.
- c. Arrival, exhibition, and departure of the poultry shall occur within a 72 hour window. The 72 hours begin when the first poultry arrive on the show grounds, whether unloaded or not, and ends when the last poultry physically leave the premises in a vehicle.
- d. Waterfowl for exhibit shall be kept separate from and apart from other poultry in a biosecure manner.
- e. An Owner Endorsed Avian Health Certificate and Biosecurity Statement or a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) shall accompany the poultry. If a CVI is used, endorsement of biosecurity on the Owner Endorsed Avian Health Certificate and Biosecurity Statement shall also accompany the poultry.
- f. All poultry on the show grounds shall be monitored for signs of illness, and any signs of illness shall be reported to the Department immediately (717-772-2852).
- g. All poultry on the show grounds shall be displayed behind barriers such as ropes to prevent public access to the poultry, with signage to prevent the public from crossing the barrier.
- h. Conveyances shall be cleaned and disinfected before loading to transport poultry to the show, and after returning to the premises of origin.

4. Avian Influenza Testing and Verification:

- a. All samples shall be collected by a Certified Poultry Technician or a Category II Accredited Veterinarian and shall be tested in a National Animal Health Laboratory Network (NAHLN) Laboratory.
- b. All poultry for exhibition shall originate from a flock in which a random, representative sample of a minimum of 30 birds, 3 weeks of age or older, were tested for avian influenza within the **14 days** prior to opening date of exhibition
- c. For waterfowl, cloacal swab samples shall be collected for testing. Swabs from geese and ducks may not be combined in the same tube for testing.
- d. For chickens, turkeys game birds, and ratites, blood samples (AGID testing) or tracheal or oropharyngeal swab samples (PCR testing) are acceptable samples.
 - i. Samples from more than one species may not be combined in the same tube for testing.
- e. The poultry shall be accompanied by the most recent test report (copy acceptable).
 - Test results shall be negative.
- f. If there are fewer than 30 birds in the flock, test all birds of age.
- g. Untested birds shall not be comingled with or added to the tested flock after negative samples have been collected and before the show.
- h. Sample collectors and testers must maintain records of animal identification, testing records, and any other records required by the Domestic Animal Law and any order issued by the Department for a minimum of two years and must make records available to the Department upon request.
 - i. National Animal Health Laboratory Network (NAHLN) protocols for sample collection, including the number of swabs/tubes of viral transport media, and testing shall be followed. All samples must be tested at a NAHLN laboratory.

OWNER ENDORSED AVIAN HEALTH CERTIFICATE AND BIOSECURITY STATEMENT 2024

Introduction: Highly pathogenic avian influenza is a fatal and contagious disease of poultry, and has led to the loss of more than 65 million birds in the US since 2022. The virus causing this disease can be spread by infected poultry, on poultry products such as feathers and eggs, on clothing and other fomites such as packing materials, and through the air. However, if all protocols for reducing the risk of spreading disease are followed, certain poultry, feathers and eggs may be exhibited, at the Department's discretion.

A completed Owner Endorsed Avian Health Certificate and Biosecurity Statement must accompany all avian species (including poultry), eggs, and feathers to a Pennsylvania exhibition. The certificate must be presented to exhibition management prior to cooping of all avian species or displaying of eggs or feathers. This form must be endorsed with the bird, egg, or feather owner's signature.

Avian. Related to birds.

Poultry. The term "poultry" includes all domesticated fowl, including chickens, turkeys, ostriches, emus, rheas, cassowaries, waterfowl, and game birds (pheasants, partridge, quail, grouse, and guineas); but excludes doves, pigeons, psittacine and passerine birds.

As established in the current *Pennsylvania Department of Agiculture Animal Health Requirements and Recommendations for Animal Exhibition, Including Commercial Exhibition,* an Owner Endorsed Avian Health Certificate and Biosecurity Statement must accompany avian species and poultry products to all animal exhibitions in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

3. Requirements for Exhibition of Feathers, Eggs, and Poultry in Pennsylvania

a. Ornamental Feathers:

- (i) Sourced in the United States.
- (ii) Ornamental feathers sourced from poultry to be entered into a competition or used to produce jewelry or other items to be exhibited/sold shall be free of visible manure, litter, or other debris.
- (iii) Transport container shall have been cleaned and disinfected before being used to transport feathers to the exhibition.

- (iv) An Owner Endorsed Avian Health Certificate and Biosecurity Statement or a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) shall accompany the feathers. If a CVI is used, endorsement of biosecurity on the Owner Endorsed Avian Health Certificate and Biosecurity Statement shall also accompany the feathers.
- (v) Ornamental feathers to be entered into a competition or used to produce jewelry or other items to be exhibited/sold shall originate from a flock which is not known to be infected with avian influenza. This requirement can be met by using one of the following methods:
 - (aa) Ornamental feathers sourced from poultry shall originate from a flock which had a negative AI test (see testing requirements for poultry below (section c) within the 14 days prior to the opening date of the exhibition. The feathers shall be accompanied by the most recent test report (copy acceptable). OR
 - (bb) Ornamental feathers sourced from poultry to be entered into a competition or used to produce jewelry or other items to be exhibited/sold shall be clean, and held in a clean area separate from poultry or other poultry products for at least 120 days at a minimum of 68 degrees Fahrenheit before exhibition. The date the feathers were moved to a holding area, along with the holding temperature, shall be included on the Owner Endorsed Avian Health Certificate and Biosecurity Statement.

b. Unfertilized Poultry Eggs for Exhibition:

- (i) Eggs shall be washed and sanitized in a 100-200 ppm chlorine solution or other EPA- approved disinfectant which is effective in destroying influenza virus, and dried before being placed in a carton.
- (ii) Eggs shall be packaged in a new cardboard or Styrofoam carton or in a plastic carton which was cleaned, disinfected, and dried, for entry into an event.
- (iii) An Owner Endorsed Avian Health Certificate and Biosecurity Statement or a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) shall accompany the eggs. If a CVI is used, endorsement of biosecurity on the Owner Endorsed Avian Health Certificate and Biosecurity Statement shall also accompany the eggs.
- (iv) The source flock shall have had a negative AI test (see testing requirements for poultry below (section c) within the 14 days prior to the openting date of the exhibition.

c. Poultry for Exhibition:

- (i) Poultry may be exhibited only if they will be moved immediately after judging directly to a facility for slaughter from the show grounds. All poultry exhibited in Pennsylvania at Department sponsored or funded exhibitions shall move as all-in and all-out directly to a Department or United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) licensed slaughter facility following the animal exhibition and may not be diverted to premises other than a recognized slaughter establishment.
- (ii) Arrival, exhibition and departure of the poultry shall occur within a 72-hour window. The 72 hours begin when the first poultry arrive on the show grounds, whether unloaded or not, and ends when the last poultry physically leave the premises in a vehicle.
- (iii) All poultry entering a show shall be identified with official Department leg bands.
- (iv) An Owner Endorsed Avian Health Certificate and Biosecurity Statement or a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) shall accompany the poultry. If a CVI is used, endorsement of biosecurity on the Owner Endorsed Avian Health Certificate and Biosecurity Statement shall also accompany the poultry.
- (v) All poultry on the show grounds shall be monitored for signs of illness, and any signs of illness shall be reported to the Department immediately (717-772-2852).
- (vi) All poultry on the show grounds shall be displayed behind barriers such as ropes to prevent public access to the poultry, with signage to prevent the public from crossing the barrier.
- (vii) Conveyances shall be cleaned and disinfected before loading to transport poultry to the show, and after returning to the premises of origin.

(viii) Avian Influenza Testing and Verification:

(aa) All samples shall be collected by a Certified Poultry Technician or a Category II Accredited Veterinarian and shall be tested in a National Animal Health Laboratory Network (NAHLN) laboratory.

(bb) All poultry for exhibition shall originate from a flock in which a random, representative sample of a minimum of 30 birds, 3 weeks of age or older, were tested for avian influenza within the **14** days prior to opening date of the exhibition.

- (cc) For waterfowl, cloacal swab samples shall be collected for testing. Swabs from geese and ducks may not be combined in the same tube for testing.
- (dd) For chickens, turkeys, game birds, and ratites, blood samples (AGID testing) or tracheal or oropharyngeal swab samples (PCR testing) are acceptable samples.
- Samples from more than one species may not be combined in the same tube for testing. (ee) The poultry shall be accompanied by the most recent test report (copy acceptable). Test results shall be negative.
- (ff) If there are fewer than 30 birds in the flock, test all birds of age.
- (gg) Untested birds shall not be comingled with or added to the tested flock after negative samples have been collected and before the show.
- **4. Verification of avian health status:** All poultry for exhibition and all source flocks for eggs and feathers being exhibited or displayed are free from evidence of infectious and contagious diseases.
- **5. Verification of biosecurity:** Biosecurity measures for all feathers, eggs, and poultry being exhibited or displayed include:
 - (i) A biosecurity plan is followed on the premises where the source flock is located, to include at minimum:
 - (aa) Visitors to bird areas are restricted.
 - (bb) Anyone visiting the poultry area should have clean clothing and should have used hand sanitizer or washed their hands before handling poultry or poultry products.
 - (cc) Designated footwear or footwear that has been cleaned and disinfected is worn in the poultry area. A clear line of separation exists at the entrance to the poultry area.
 - (ii) All feathers and eggs are maintained apart from the poultry flock prior to entry into the exhibition.
 - (iii) All conveyances, including transport vehicles, coops, crates, boxes, and other containers used to transport animals or products to the show are cleaned to be free of visible manure, litter, or other debris.
 - (iv) All coops, crates, boxes, and other containers used to transport animals or products to the show shall be disinfected with a product effective against the avian influenza virus and allowed to dry before use.
 - (v) All exibitors should follow the biosecurity guidelines: *Keeping Your Show Animals Healthy- Guidelines for Exhibitors* (11/28/23).
