# Greetings Fellow Exhibitors,

The Central Florida Heritage Poultry Classic is excited to announce its Annual Exhibition Poultry Show. It saddened our heart to have cancelled last year's show. We thank everyone for your patience as we worked to get it arranged for this year.

It is our goal in organizing this event is to promote the poultry industry. The Board and members want to extend to you and your friends a very special invitation to exhibit your birds at the facilities of the KVLS/Osceola County Fairground. This facility has an air-conditioned main show room and ventilated barn area with plenty of room for everyone.

This event is open to all adult and youth poultry exhibitors in the United States. With two APA and ABA sanctioned shows, a YEPA sanctioned Junior show with Showmanship, raffles, vendors, swap, good food, and more, you are certain to have a good time and make new friends. Youth birds are only judged once.

We require that your birds be NPIP certified and tested prior to the show. For youth who plan on showing in other shows within 90 days before our show please get a band if you are not NPIP certified and plan on showing at our show. A representative from the Florida State Department of Agriculture will be on-site to test your poultry. There is no cost for this test. Due to the history of Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza, Florida requires anyone coming in from out of state to get a permit before bringing your birds in.

We will also have camper water/power hookup available for \$<u>35</u> night with/without hookup. Sorry No Tents. Registration online only.

It would be helpful to have some volunteers to help us. There is a lot to do and help is always appreciated. Entries can be done online with payment thru credit card on a secure site UNTIL 3/12/23. There is \$1.00 convenience fee. Otherwise, entries can be mailed in with payment by check or money order but must be received by 3/10/23. Any changes you may do so by email by 3/12/23.

# Show Rules and Regulations

- 1. NO ONE is allowed to coop out prior to the completion of the awards ceremony! Please be respectful and stay to support your fellow exhibitors.
- 2. All reasonable care will be taken. Central Heritage Poultry Classic (CHPC) and its officers and members or the Osceola County Fairgrounds will not be responsible for accidents, losses, or damages incurred at the show or associated with the show.
- **3.** No hay, carpet, or cardboard allowed in cages.
- 4. Competition is open to all Purebred Bantam, Large Fowl, Turkey, Ducks, Geese, and Helmeted Guinea.
- 5. All birds must be cooped <u>Saturday by 8:45 AM</u>. Judging begins at 9:00 AM.
- 6. Building will be open Friday at 4:30 PM and close at 9 PM for early check-in.
- 7. Only judge, clerk, and show officials will be allowed in aisles during judging.
- 8. All birds that appear sick in the show will be removed from the area.
- **9.** Handle only your own birds unless you have permission from the owner. If you see someone handling someone else's birds, and you know they are not the owner, please stop them and contact a CHPC member. THANK YOU!
- **10.** No alcoholic beverages or intoxicating substances allowed.
- 11. No smoking in or near the Showroom please!
- 12. CHPC reserves the right to add, substitute, or cancel judges if needed.
- 13. The judges' decision is final, and any protest must be followed by APA/ABA rules.
- 14. Anything not covered by these rules will be handled by the show committee.
- 15. Water cups will not be supplied. Exhibitors must bring their own containers.
- **16.** Junior Show is not a double show and is for those 4 -18 years of age.
- 17. A single bird cannot be used in both the Open Show and Junior Show
- 18. <u>BIRDS WILL BE RELEASED IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING AWARD PRESENTATION. NO BIRDS WILL BE RELEASED</u> BEFORE THE AWARDS PRESENTATION IS OVER.

- 1. All exhibitors must be entered in the Poultry Show.
- 2. Age groups are: Pee Wee (4-7) Jr (8-10) Int (11-13) Sr (14-18)
- 3. Dress code for Showmanship closed toe shoes, long pants, collar shirt or full show FFA attire.

# Youth Egg Competition

### ENTRIES

- 5. All exhibitors must be entered in the Poultry Show. There is no entry fee.
- 6. There shall be no identification marks on the eggs but an Egg Information Card must be attached to carton.
- 7. Eggs must be turned in at time of check-in with a completed Egg Information Card attached.
- 8. Limit One Dozen eggs per exhibitor.

### EGG SPECIFICATIONS

1. All eggs shown must be chicken eggs and selected by the exhibitor. They need not be produced by exhibitor's flocks.

- 2. Eggs are not to be purchased from a grocery store.
- 3. All eggs must be entered as a single dozen. An Egg Information Card must be filled out and attached to the carton. **Limit One Dozen** eggs per exhibitor.
- 4. There will be a Pee Wee, Small, Medium, Large, Extra Large, and Jumbo Class. Provided enough eggs entered, they may be broken down by white or brown.
  - Pee Wee eggs shall be not less than 15 ounces per dozen.
  - Small eggs shall be not less than 18 ounces per dozen.
  - Medium eggs shall be not less than 21 ounces per dozen.
  - Large eggs shall be not less than 24 ounces per dozen.
  - Extra Large eggs shall be not less than 27 ounces per dozen.
  - Jumbo eggs shall be not less than 30 ounces per dozen.
- 5. A dozen eggs of minimum average weight for the class shall receive as many points, other things being equal as a dozen eggs of maximum average weight for the class.
- 6. Eggs will be judged on interior as well as exterior quality.

#### **DISPLAY AND JUDGING**

- 1. The Superintendent of the Youth Poultry & Egg Show will see that the exhibits are properly displayed.
- 2. Judging will be done on same day of the Show. Results will be shown at the end of the day.
- 3. The eggs become the property of the Show.
- 4. The top 3 dozen eggs for each class will receive ribbons. All peewee youth entries exhibited will receive a participation ribbon.

# Egg Decorating Contest

- The top 3 in each division, Junior, Intermediate, and Senior divisions will receive rosettes.
- Only one egg per exhibitor.
- Must be turned in at time of check-in.
- Eggs MUST be blown out.
- Eggs may be decorated with paint, feathers, paper, crayons, etc.
- Eggs must be decorated by exhibitor.

# Directions

Orlando International Airport:

Following SOUTH EXIT signs from the airport. Proceed south on Boggy Creek Road, go under toll road 417, then one mile to stop light (Circle K on one corner); turn right (name of street is still Boggy Creek Road). Follow this (name changes to Simpson Road) to U.S. Highway 192, turn right, to next stop light. Fortune Road. Turn right. Main entrance to Osceola Heritage Park is about one block on left. Follow signs.

### I-4 Westbound:

Take Exit #77, to Florida's Turnpike South. See below for Turnpike southbound.

### Turnpike Southbound:

Take Exit #244 (Kissimmee-St. Cloud) turn right (west) onto U.S. Highway 192; go through stop light at Simpson Road to next stop light at Bill Beck Blvd. (approximately one mile). Turn right. Main entrance to Osceola Heritage Park is about one block on the left. Follow signs.

### Turnpike Northbound:

Take Exit #242 (Kissimmee-St. Cloud) turn left (west) onto U.S. Highway 192; go approximately two miles to net stop light at Bill Beck Blvd. Turn right. Main entrance to Osceola Heritage Park is about one block on the left. Follow signs.

### I-4 Eastbound:

Take Exit #65. Osceola Parkway (\$1.50 toll), proceed east 9.1 miles to Michigan Avenue (third traffic light after the toll booth). Turn right on Michigan to U.S. Highway 192 (at the fourth traffic light); turn left and follow U.S. Highway 192 to Bill Beck Blvd. Turn Left. Main entrance to Osceola Heritage Park is about one block on the left.

### I-95 Northbound:

Take Exit #180 to U.S. Highway 192 West. Follow U.S. Highway 192 to Bill Beck Blvd. Turn right. Follow signs to Main entrance. Osceola Heritage Park is about one block on the left. Follow signs.

### I-95 Southbound:

Take Exit #205B, to Route 528, the Beachline Expressway. Exit the Beachline at Route 417 south (the Greenway). Exit 417 at Exit #17, to Boggy Creek Road south. Follow Boggy Creek one mile to stop light, turn right onto Boggy Creek Road to U.S. Highway 192 (approximately 5.3 miles) (street name changes to Simpson road). Turn right on U.S. Highway 192, to next traffic light, Bill Beck Blvd. Turn right. Follow signs to Main entrance. Osceola Heritage Park is about one block on the left. Follow signs.
