SHOW RULES

Date: Saturday, October 9, 2021
Check-in: 6:00a.m.-7a.m.
Show starts at 9:30a.m.
Market goats must be weighed in during check-in. Scale closes at 9a.m.

Entries: Entry deadline is October 1st (postmarked by) and late entries will be accepted until 7a.m. on day of the show. ***Cash only on day of show.***

Location: KVLS Arena – 1911 Kissimmee Valley Lane, Kissimmee, FL 34744

General Rules: The Kowtown Showdown is open to all active members of 4-H and FFA. Exhibitors under the age of 6 must be accompanied by an adult in the ring.

This show requires you to show off of your trailer. There is a designated wash area as well as electric. You are also welcome to bring a generator.

The show committee reserves the final right to interpret these rules, settle and determine all matters and questions arising from or connected to the Kowtown Showdown. Any exhibitor who violates the rules will forfeit all privileges and such penalties as the committee may deem reasonable.

An official certificate of veterinary inspection must be presented at time of check-in dated within 90 days (30 days for out of state animals) of show.

The exhibitor is liable for any damages his/her goat may incur and also for the safety of his/her goats. Kowtown Showdown and Kissimmee Valley Livestock Show assumes no responsibility or liability for any damages. If any goat is a threat to the public the animal will be removed from the show area. Poor sportsmanship will not be tolerated. The judge's decision is final and should be respected.

Show Rules: Dairy does, meat does and meat bucks will be shown by age and broken into separate classes. Class schedule is reflected on the following page. Market goats will be shown by weight and will be weighed at check-in. List of classes will be posted after check-in is completed. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion will be awarded and receive a payout. Showmanship will be divided into Peewee (7 and under), Junior (8-10), Intermediate (11-13) and Senior (14-18 and has not yet graduated High School). Exhibitors have the option to use any goat entered on their entry form for Showmanship.

There is no limit to the number of animals an exhibitor may enter in the show. A minimum of 10 animals are required to have each division. The show committee reserves the right to combine or split classes as necessary.
