## **RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

- Only the winners of showmanship for the Junior, Intermediate and Senior class of Market Goats, Market Hogs, Market Lambs and Market Steers are eligible to compete. If there is a double winner only the primary will be represented to show and the 2<sup>nd</sup> place winner from the secondary animal will be pulled up to show. If the winner does not want to participate in the contest, it will be offered to the 2<sup>nd</sup> place winner in that age group.
- Contestants will compete for the round robin showmanship showing each of these animals in your age class for the all-around winner.
- Contestants will be required to wear white long sleeve collared dress shirt or blouse, tucked in with nice clean jeans or western dress trousers. Boots or close toed leather shoes are required. Exhibitors may wear a 4-H or FFA jacket. A 4-H or FFA tie may be worn if the exhibitor desires. No other jackets, vests or ties will be allowed.
- Only one winner from each age group will be selected. All judge's decisions will be final.
- Any exhibitor conducting or participating in any illegal activities on the fairgrounds and any surrounding areas so used during the fair shall forfeit all rights to show at the fair.
- There will be a meeting to fill out an information sheet about themselves and go over any questions or concerns.
- The Board of Directors of the KVLS & Fair will have the final judgement in regard to the interpretation of ALL rules and regulations.
