The breed of chicken will be changed each year (ex: Red Sexlink one year, Barred Rocks the next, followed by Rhode Island Reds). Only the best 3 (trio) will be shown in this division. The breed this year will be the **AUSTRALORP** (back up will be Sussex or Leg Horn)

The chicks will be handed out on August 21, 2021 at 4:00 PM.

The Poultry Workshop will be September 25, 2021 at 8:30 am where the Skill-a-thon book will be given out and gone through.

SECTION 9 | PRODUCTION POULTRY PROGRAM

PRODUCTION POULTRY RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. Each participant would declare their interest in the project **by 7/29/2021** by registering and paying for the chicks (must confirm final number **by 7/30/2021** in order to receive on time for pickup date **of 8/21/2021**.
 - Each participant may purchase up to twelve (12) chicks at \$3.75 each (minimum of 3).
 - Poultry Committee will order the chicks (pullets only of egg laying breeds) from a hatchery (can use different ones each year or every other year), recommend 5 or 6 per contestant.
 - The breed of chicken will be changed each year (ex: Red Sexlink one-year, Barred Rocks the next, followed by Rhode Island Reds). This year is. The **AUSTRALORP** (Backup will be the SUSSEX or LEGHORN)
 - The chicks will be handed out at KVLS **on 8/21/2021 AT 4:00PM**. The Poultry Workshop is scheduled for **September 25, 2021**. Sign in is at 8:30 am for all. The Skill-a-thon book will be handed out at the workshop. New information will also be given out, please attend.  - Please sign up so we can have enough supplies on hand.
 - **MANDATORY PRE-FAIR WORKSHOP in January. All exhibitors are to attend to receive updated fair information and changes. YOUTH MUST ATTEND THE HANDS-ON BATHING/PEST CONTROL PORTION OF THE WORKSHOP IN JANUARY, if they have not previously done so** (see calendar for exact dates & times). **Hands on portion will begin right after the Pre-Fair portion.** Please bring one bird per family and any grooming materials for hands on workshop. **ANY QUESTIONS PLEASE CONTACT THE POULTRY CHAIR OR CO-CHAIR.**
 - Birds will arrive at the same time as the other poultry and be tested.
 - The child will present their best three (3) of the chicks for a trio, which they bought from the Committee for the fair.
 - All poultry are required to be free of disease, parasites and mites. Poultry not free, will be disqualified. All poultry will be tested at check in.
 - The Trio will be cooped together in one pen.
 - Exhibitor must provide food and water containers. Recommended secured or heavy enough not to tip over.
 - The Poultry Judge **will judge the birds** in their pen during the Poultry Show as its own Division.
 - The Trio will be judged as a group with Premium and Ribbons: a. Blue - \$15.00
 - b. Red - \$9.00
 - c. White - \$6.00
 - d. The Trio will be judged as a group for Grand and Reserve. Premium: Grand \$50, Reserve \$25.
 - Any additional birds may be shown in the Youth Poultry Show in the appropriate class.
 - Skill-a-thon & Showmanship contests are highly recommended. Showmanship will be on Sunday of the show at 2:30 PM. The Skill-a-thon is on the 2nd Saturday of the fair at 9AM, awards are at 3PM.
