There are 3 categories of entrants: Exhibitor must choose between **Beginner**, **Intermediate**, and **Advanced**. One CANNOT enter more than one category.

Beginner: Those who have been turning for less than two (2) years.

Intermediate: Those who have been turning for more than two (2) years but less than seven (7) years.

Advanced: Those who have been turning for seven (7) years or more.

Note well: Those who teach or demonstrate woodturning, those who have sold more than ten (10) items and/or those who have ever sold a single item for more than \$100.00 can enter in **Advanced Group** only, regardless of the number of years turning.
