Buildings

1. Davis Event Center

- \$4,000.00 per day <u>or</u> 12% of gate, whichever is greater.
 - **Meeting/Conference Rooms**: \$500.00 per day (if rented separate from Davis Event Center).
 - Please note, our contracted restaurant/food vendor has exclusive food rights to the Davis Event Center and immediate grounds area outside the building. All food and/or catering associated with events in this facility must be coordinated through the vendor (Kendall Huntley: 828-775-7744, if possible, send a text and he will respond in a timely manner).

2. McGough Arena

- Livestock/Equine Events (includes covered arena except for housing livestock).
 - \$2,500.00 or 12% of gate, whichever is greater.
- Non-Livestock/Equine Events
 - \$3,000.00 minimum or 12% of gate, whichever is greater.
 - McGough Arena Covered Ring: \$700.00 per day.
 - Non-event day lighting fee of \$50.00 per hour between 5:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m.
 - All-night fee: \$200.00 per night.
 - Agricultural youth events and/or educational clinics may receive a 25% discount on McGough Arena rates when the facilities are left in clean condition. The WNC Agricultural Center management reserves final judgment as to what qualifies.
 - Please note, our contracted restaurant/food vendor has exclusive food rights to the McGough Arena and immediate grounds area outside the building. All food and/or catering associated with events in this facility must be coordinated through the vendor (Kendall Huntley: 828-775-7744, if possible, send a text and he will respond in a timely manner).

3. Expo Building

\$3,000.00 per day or 12% of gate, whichever is greater.

4. Virginia C. Boone Meeting Center (*Recommended Capacity*: 250 Banquet Style or 325 Theater Style)

- \$2,000.00 per day (Friday Sunday, or Holidays) or 12% of gate, whichever is greater.
- \$1,000.00 per day (Monday Thursday) <u>or</u> 12% of gate, whichever is greater.

5. Livestock Sales Arena and Barn

- Livestock Events
 - \$700.00 per day <u>or</u> 12% of gate, whichever is greater.
 - Youth livestock events may receive a 25% discount when participation is restricted to youth.
- Non-Livestock Events
 - \$800.00 per day <u>or</u> 12% of gate, whichever is greater.

6. Barn F (Paved Area)

• \$800.00 per day <u>or</u> 12% of gate, whichever is greater.

7. Pony Express Restaurant

- \$300.00 per day, which includes a maximum of 16 rectangular tables and 128 chairs.
 - If food is served, our on-site food service must have first refusal for catering. If they decline, an outside vendor may be used, and the facility catering fee will apply.

<u>Grounds</u>

1. Outdoor Grounds (Upper and/or Lower Fairgrounds)

12¢ per square yard (\$500.00 minimum) per day <u>or</u> 12% of gate receipts, whichever is greater.
Ground rental alone does NOT include restroom facilities.

Other Associated Information

1. Building Rental Fees

• Daily rental fees are as listed above <u>or</u> 12% of ticket gross, whichever is greater.

2. Building Rental Period

- Daily rental period is from 7:00 a.m. till midnight.
 - For private parties/events, the daily rental period is from 7:00 a.m. till 11:00 p.m.

3. Setup/Cleanup Days

- Setup and/or cleanup days are \$300.00 per day per building, or use of grounds. The period of time allowed is 8:00 a.m. till 5:00 p.m.
 - For private parties/events, the period of time allowed for a setup day is 8:00 a.m. till 4:00 p.m. The period of time allowed for a cleanup day is 8:00 a.m. till noon. The cost for a cleanup day is \$100.00.

4. Additional Time

• Additional time is \$150.00 per hour, outside of the stated facility rental day rental period (7:00 a.m. till midnight) or setup/cleanup day period (8:00 a.m. till 5:00 p.m.).
