- Each entry must be grown, cared for from seed to harvest, and exhibited by the grower.
- All entries will be discarded when unsuitable for display.
- Exhibitor must provide help to place heavy garden vegetables on display and also help to remove them when display is released.

*Superintendents or their family members are not eligible to enter exhibits in the department(s) they are overseeing for competition but can be used for Display Only

Hints for good Horticultural fair entries:

- 1. Pay attention to maturity dates.
- 2. Control pests.
- 3. Select blemish-free produce.
- 4. Uniform size is the best selection. Example: Carrots, any type (all 3 carrots should be close to the same size).
- 5. Quality
- 6. Color
- 7. Make sure your entry is in the right class.
- 8. Be sure to prepare the exhibits according to catalog instructions.
- 9. Please indicate variety on entry tag.

- Exhibitor must provide help to place these garden vegetables on display and also help to remove them when display is released.
- Weigh-in will be from 3-7 p.m. on Tuesday, September 3rd only. Any item placed on the scale must be displayed until the end of the Fair.
- Items needing to be loaded by forklift must be picked up before 5:00 pm on Monday, September 16th.
- Product must be in good condition.
- If the entries become unsuitable for display, the exhibitor will be notified concerning the removal of the product.
- Placing is based on weight of entry.
- If an item is placed on the scale, it must be displayed until the end of the fair, otherwise ALL premiums received by the exhibitor will be forfeited.
- The Fair will not be liable for any damage caused to the giants of the garden unloading, display, during the fair or loading after the fair.
