- There shall not be more than one ribbon awarded and one award paid for each placement in a class.

*** Superintendents or their family members are not eligible to enter exhibits in the department(s) they are overseeing for competition but can be used for Display Only.**

Professional-Any person connected with a jewelry craft business or workshop as owner or instructor or anyone making pieces or working for personal monetary gain from their hobby. In this category, special consideration will be given to pieces with completely hand-fabricated components (no purchased findings).

- Material Quality = 20
- Color Selection = 20
- Originality = 20
- Artistry = 20
