RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Homeschoolers need to enter in the individual student art competition.
- Any public, private, charter etc. school in North Carolina is invited to participate.
 - Entries are to be entered under the school's name, using the school's EIN for tax purposes.
 - The student work should be part of a school assignment within the school year, September 2023-September 2024.
 - Each school can enter one entry per division class based on grades offered at their school.
- Each school must submit six (6) individual entries by six (6) different individual students.
 - Artwork should be a variety of techniques and styles.
 - Each piece of the entry (all 6 pieces) must be placed on black or white foam core boards with all boards being attached, not to exceed 8 feet in height and 4 feet in width.
 - When binding the school's artwork into a single unit, grommets, string, ribbon, etc. are recommended.
 - Remember, the Expo center can be extremely humid.
 - Ensure appropriate hanging device is attached for display purposes. The artwork will be displayed on gridwall.
- All six (6) entries from the participating school should be received in a manner that is easy to handle and identify. List school, teacher, and student info on the back of each piece of artwork.
- The Mountain State Fair reserves the right to refuse pieces that it considers not in good taste (i.e., nude figures, hand gestures or illegal controlled substances).
- ***Superintendents or their family members are not eligible to enter exhibits in the department(s) they are overseeing for competition but can be used for Display Only.**

CRITERIA FOR JUDGING SCHOOL ART:

Overall (Student technical quality, Age appropriate)	= 30
At least 3 quality lessons (using different Media)	= 30
Presentation (Overall presentation of the school art)	= 25
Followed artwork presentations in rule book	= 15
Total = 100
