RULES AND REGULATIONS

Please read important information on preceding pages 4, 8, and 9.

- All entries must be the work of the exhibitor.
- All entries must have been completed between September 2023 and September 2024 and must not have won a blue ribbon in any past Mountain State Fair.

*** Superintendents or their family members are not eligible to enter exhibits in the department(s) they are overseeing for competition but can be used for Display Only.**

Criteria for Judging Wood Turning

- Imagination, Design, Originality, and Artistic expression in wood = 30
- Workmanship- Evidence of good tool technique and smooth profile = 25
- Difficulty – Complexity of geometry, multiple wood parts, multiple axis = 25
- Finish – Finish consistently and evenly applied (Absence of runs, marks, patchiness, and dust free) = 20
- Total = 100

There are 3 categories of entrants: Exhibitor must choose between **Beginner**, **Intermediate**, and **Advanced**. One CANNOT enter more than one category.

Beginner: Those who have been turning for less than two (2) years.

Intermediate: Those who have been turning for more than two (2) years but less than seven (7) years.

Advanced: Those who have been turning for seven (7) years or more.

Note well: Those who teach or demonstrate woodturning, those who have sold more than ten (10) items and/or those who have ever sold a single item for more than \$100.00 must enter **Advanced Group** only, regardless of the number of years turning.
