#### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

### Please read important information on preceding pages 4, 8, and 9.

- Space is limited. Open on a first come, first served basis.
- Scarecrow must be garden useable, whimsical, humorous, mischievous, or loveable—NOT frightening. Monsters, gruesome, bloody, or especially scary.
- Exhibitor must use natural material like hay, straw, etc.
- Clothing and props may be used but no firearms (real or fake), no vulgar or suggestive decoration will be allowed.
- Scarecrow must be built by the exhibitor from scratch (commercial creations and pre-molded or commercial face masks are not permitted).
- Scarecrow must be between 5' and 7' tall and attached to a wooden base no larger than a 3' X 3'.
- Floor covering or decoration may be applied to the base.
- No Commercial or Political party signs of ANY KIND are allowed.
- Select a name for the scarecrow and attach it to scarecrow or base.
- Scarecrows must be assembled prior to arrival at the fair.

\*Superintendents or their family members are not eligible to enter exhibits in the department(s) they are overseeing for competition but can be used for Display Only.
